Go Clubs Go Mow

The intent of Go Mow to provide local not for profit clubs with the option to purchase retired mowers from Council at a reduced rate to:

- Promote the sustainability of clubs
- Improve field maintenance and overall field presentation
- Encourage greater ownership of field maintenance by clubs

Priority Areas:

- Clubs with lease or management agreements over facilities and turf based sporting fields
- Multi-use facilities
- Clubs with aged or damaged field maintenance equipment
- Clubs residing on landfill sites with subsidence issues

Assistance Type

- The program provides clubs with the opportunity to purchase retired Council lawnmowers at a reduced rate
- There is no cash or in kind component to this program
- Council will not enter into a payment plan or financing arrangement with the club, payment must be made in full

Application Lodgement

- There will be two funding rounds per year
- The application must be lodged at least one month before the proposed assistance is required
- Only one successful application per year is permitted

Eligible Applicants must

- Be recognised as a Level Four (4) Accredited Club with Council's 'Go Clubs' programme
- Be a not-for-profit organisation
- Occupy a facility with a turf field by way of lease, hire or user agreement
- Be able to pay for the total cost of the mower upon completion of the agreement

Assessment Criteria

- Does the project align with the Community Grant Objectives? If yes, which objectives will your project align with? (15% weighting)
- Outline the clubs need for the mower (25% weighting)

- Is your club currently responsible for field maintenance? If so, at which facility? (10% weighting)
- Evidence of the capability of the Organisation to pay for the mower (please provide copies of financial statements) (20% weighting)
- Does your club currently have a mower and what is its condition? (15% weighting)
- Does your project benefit a large number of groups, not just your club? If so, who are they? (15% weighting)

Assessment Criteria

- The application will be assessed by a panel of three Council Officers
- The delegation level for decisions will be the Team Leader Sport and Recreation in consultation with the Chair of the Community Services committee
