RATES & ACCESS CHARGES

- Rate rise: 2.5%
- Water and sewerage access rise: 2.5%
- Water usage charges: increases by 20c a kilolitre to \$1.43 a kilolitre. (compares with water usage in Southeast Qld at more than \$4 a kilolitre)

Total rates bill increase for those on the minimum

\$1.15 a week Total rates bill increase for those with median priced property

\$1.25 a week

The Capital Works program includes \$50.5 million for improvements to our transport and drainage network; \$49.3 million for water, wastewater and resource recovery infrastructure, and \$14 million for community, sport and cultural projects.

Some of the highlights of the Capital Works program are:

- \$26.8 million on improvements to the road network
- **\$21.3 million** for improvements to the wastewater network and treatment plants
- **\$6 million** for a new animal management facility in Links Drive
- \$4.6 million for the creation of footpaths, pathways and to promote Active Travel
- \$4.5 million for parks and foreshores
- \$4.4 million for consultancy, design and early works for the Cairns Water Security Stage 1 project
- \$3.7 million for major upgrade of Griffiths Park Sporting Precinct
- \$3 million for the refurbishment of the Henley Hill No 5 Reservoir

- \$3 million for the water main refurbishment program
- **\$2.4 million** for new kerb and channel as part of the Suburban Enhancement Program
- **\$2 million** to progress the Cairns Gallery Precinct
- **\$1.9 million** for pedestrian and road bridge projects
- \$1.7 million for drainage improvements
- \$1.5 million Tanks Arts Centre ugrades
- **\$1.2 million** for upgrades to aquatic facilities
- \$1 million for street lighting upgrades
- \$670,000 for improvements to parks, playgrounds and the provision of public toilets
- \$500,000 to expand and improve our comprehensive CCTV network

OTHER OPERATING EXPENDITURE

- \$44 million for the annual maintenance of community assets including 630 parks and nature areas; 600 kilometres of sealed footpaths; more than 200 connecting footbridges; 820 litter bins; and 100 toilet blocks.
- \$3.4 million to fund tourism marketing and promotion
- \$2 million to provide security services to boost safety in the CBD
- \$1.5 million in cash and in-kind grants to community, sporting and cultural organisations
- **\$1.4 million** to provide lifesavers at the Esplanade lagoon and beaches
- \$1 million to attract and support major events
- **\$500,000** to boost the proactive management of animals






