

## 9.2 Statewide codes

### 9.2.1 Community residence code

#### 9.2.1.1 Application

- (1) This code applies to assessing development for a Community residence.
- (2) When using this code, reference should be made to Part 5.

#### 9.2.1.2 Purpose

- (1) The purpose of the community residence code is for assessing material change of use for a community residence.

#### 9.2.1.3 Criteria for assessment

Part A - Criteria for self-assessable development

**Table 9.2.1.3.a – Community residence code - self-assessable development**

Acceptable outcomes (AO)	
<b>AO1</b>	The maximum number of residents is six.
<b>AO2</b>	One support worker is permitted to reside on the premises at any time.
<b>AO3</b>	The maximum number of support workers attending any daytime activity shall not exceed seven people over a 24 hour period.
<b>AO4</b>	Resident and visitor parking is provided on site for a minimum of 2 vehicles. One vehicle space must be dedicated for parking for support services.
