What will panel members do?

Between June 2023 and the end of 2024, panel members will play an active role in helping Council shape our predicted growth in a positive way. You will learn about the present and future growth challenges facing our community, as well as different ways these challenges might be met. Your input will help us protect and embrace all the things that make Cairns special.

Panel members will be asked to explore ideas through a small number of activities including surveys, online polls and workshops or meetings. We'll give you plenty of notice before each activity, and we understand that you might not be able to take part in everything. We will also provide support to help everyone participate.

We understand that your time and input is valuable. As a thank you, panel members will go into regular prize draws for e-gift cards (up to \$250 each) during the project. Members who complete more complex and time-consuming engagement activities will be reimbursed with e-gift cards. The value of these cards will vary depending on the type of task.

Who chooses the panel members?

Panel members will be chosen by an independent non-profit organisation that specialises in recruiting and selecting people to take part in these kind of events. We want to capture broad community views, so panel members will represent a wide variety of interests, ages, abilities, lived experience, skills and knowledge. Council is not involved in the selection of panel representatives.



Council seeks support for projects
