



## Terms and Conditions:

- I hereby apply for registration of the animal described above and declare that the details are correct to the best of my knowledge.
- I recognise that failure to comply with the Cairns Regional Council Local Laws or the *Animal Management (Cats and Dogs) Act 2008* may result in the Council taking action against myself.
- I have provided a sufficient enclosure to contain my animal in accordance with the Cairns Regional Council Local Laws. Keeping of dog/s on a lead or runners is not considered a sufficient enclosure. I understand that failure to keep my animals within the enclosure could result in action being taken against myself.
- I acknowledge my dog/s must be walked on a chain, cord or leash by a person who is physically able to control the animal.
- I acknowledge that I am only allowed to keep four (4) animals (max 2 dogs and 2 cats) per property. Dogs are not permitted to be kept at accommodation units unless approved by Cairns Regional Council.
- I understand that my animals must wear the registration tag at all times. Should the tag become lost and/or damaged, I must make application with Cairns Regional Council for a replacement tag forthwith.
- I understand that it is a requirement under the *Animal Management (Cats and Dogs) Act 2008*, that my animal have a permanent identification device (microchip) implanted in it.

### Please note:

- All dogs over the age of three (3) months must be registered and microchipped.
- Animal registration is not subject to GST.
- Under the *Animal Management (Cats and Dogs) Act 2008*, if you own an American Pit Bull Terrier or Pit Bull Terrier, Dogo Argentino, Fila Brasileiro (known as Brazilian Mastiff), Japanese Tosa or Perro de Presa Canario (or Presa Canario) you must apply to Council for a permit to keep a Restricted Dog.

### This application is only available to the following dogs:

- Dogs owned by pensioners who hold a current Centrelink Aged Pensioner Concession Card or other Pensioner Concession Card holders who would otherwise be eligible for the Aged Pension.  
**\*\*Pensioner concession card holders eligibility is determined by reference to Centrelink Aged Pensioner criteria which is currently at least 65 (subject to change)\*\***
- Registered Guide Dogs
- Registered Hearing Dogs
- Registered Assistance Dogs
- All dogs must be desexed and microchipped to be eligible.

### Documentation as listed below must be presented with this application:

#### Aged Pensioner Registration:

- Certificate of Sterilisation or letter from Veterinarian.
- Microchipping Certificate including microchip identification number.
- Centrelink Aged Pensioner Concession Card - (Or other Eligible Pensioner Concession Card (eg Veteran Affairs, Disability) with proof of age.

#### Guide/Hearing or Assistance Dogs Registration:

- Certificate of Sterilisation or letter from Veterinarian.
- Microchipping Certificate including microchip identification number.
- Certificate from an organisation recognised by legislation showing the dog is trained as a Guide/Hearing or Assistance Dog
