### Introduction

Cattana Wetlands is one of three birding hotspots within, or close to, the Cairns CBD - the others being Cairns Esplanade and the Centenary Lakes/Botanic Gardens Precinct. During single visits to Cattana, up to 72 species have been observed.

The iconic birds at Cattana Wetlands include the Green Pygmy-Goose, White-browed Crake, Comb-crested Jacana, Black-necked Stork (aka Jabiru), Black Bittern and Crimson Finch.

### Notes for the list

This third edition (2021) is adapted from Dave Anderson's 2019 taxonomic collation. His key, based on frequency of observations 'at Cattana', is included:

**C** - Common; **U** - Uncommon; **R** - Rare; **S** - Seasonal; **I** - Introduced.

This 2021 list is collated by Jennifer Muir and is presented in alphabetical order, as seen in most field guide indexes, for easy use. The order is based on group common name (e.g. **Bittern**), followed underneath by species common name (e.g. **Australian Little**), as for **Australian Little Bittern**; and scientific name (*Ixobrychus dubius*); as referenced from Menkhorst *et al.* (2017).

Jennifer's key is as follows:

1. **prev**: the added previous (prev.) common or scientific names based on: Simpson K & Day N (2010). Field Guide to the Birds of Australia. Penguin Group (Australia). Previous names have been included for clarity;
2. **aka (also known as)**: some species are also known by alternative name(s), as at April 2021. The term "aka" for common and/or scientific names is also based on Simpson & Day (*ibid.*);
3. **Conserv.**: Conservation;
4. **Nat.**: Nature;
5. **ssp.**: subspecies.

Jennifer has also included conservation status, whereby birds are protected under the Federal Government Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 (EPBC Act 1999) and some under the Queensland State Legislation Nature Conservation Act 1992 (Nat. Cons. Act 1992).
