

GO CLUBS INFRASTRUCTURE ASSISTANCE GRANT





WHAT IS IT?

- The intent of the Go Clubs Infrastructure Assistance grant is to assist local not for profit sport, recreation, arts, culture and community organisations with the development of improved facilities.
- This grant is a competitive grant stream and is open for applications from 3 July 2023 31 August 2023.
- The Go Clubs Infrastructure Assistance grant provides assistance through cash funding for approved applicants. The maximum amount per application is \$25,000 (GST ex).
- The budget is capped and the grant is highly competitive (2022/23 we received 44 eligible applicants budget allowed us to support 16).

IS MY CLUB ELIGIBLE?

Be registered with Council's Go Clubs Program.

- If not, register at Go Clubs website <u>www.cairns.qld.gov.au/goclubs</u>
- New website all clubs need to re-register (for further information please refer to slide 12)

Be a registered Not-for-Profit organisation.

- Occupy a facility that is owned in freehold by the organisation or subject to a long-term, noncommercial lease arrangement.
 - This includes clubs not leasing directly from Council.



IS MY PROJECT ELIGIBLE

Projects that will be considered as part of the IA grant include but are not limited to:

Building Work

- New building or shed
- Extension to existing building/s
- Removal of buildings/structures
- All ability improvements eg disability access
- Shipping Containers
- Storage
- Decking/Veranda/Patio
- Internal building works/refurbishment
- Skylights

Electrical/Mechanical/Fire/Security

- Electrical upgrades
- Fire upgrades
- Air conditioning
- Fans
- Solar Panels
- Field/court lighting (new/upgrades)
- Other Lighting
- NB: Applications for equipment, field remediation and vehicles are ineligible.

- Land, Grounds, Fields
- Shade structures
- Activity related infrastructure eg goal posts, player shelters, grandstands, dugouts, scoreboards etc
- New or upgrades fields/courts
 - Fencing
- Signage
- Filling/earthworks
- Drainage
- Playground equipment
- Tree or vegetation work
- Carpark upgrades

Plumbing

- Bores
- Water tanks
- Irrigation
- Water connections

- Your club may apply for *only one* project
 - multiple projects in a single application is not allowed
 - Creative grant writing may allow multiple projects under one banner (solar and AC as energy efficiency for example)
 - Contact the Club Development
 Officer to discuss proposed project.



IS MY PROJECT ELIGIBLE

- Project must meet 1 or more of the grant objectives.
 - > The grants aims to support renewed or upgraded Community Infrastructure that:
 - Ensures club assets remain relevant and continue to meet relevant standards
 - > Enhances accessibility of community facilities to increase use and promote inclusion
 - Improves Club capacity and viability
 - Contributes to greater community safety



DO I NEED COUNCIL APPROVAL?

Improvement works form

- A lessee of Council's is required to request approval before making "improvements, additions or alterations within a leased, permitted or licensed area Or area subject to management or user agreements".
 - ▶ If in doubt contact the Club Development Officer.
- In order to seek approval submit an Improvement Works form form can be found <u>www.cairns.qld.gov.au</u> and search 'Improvement Works form'.
- This allows the Council to undertake a preliminary assessment of the project (ensuring no issues with masterplans, future plans, etc).
- Within 4 weeks, Council will assess and assuming no concerns return a letter of "in principle" support.
- This does not constitute a Development Application (DA) conditions of the letters of support may indicate that support is given conditional of the club seeking DA with Council's planners.
- Letter can be attached to all future grant applications as evidence of Landowners consent.



WHAT ARE THE TIMEFRAMES?

Key Dates

3 July 2023	Infrastructure Assistance Grant opens
31 July 2023	Expressions of Interest close*
4 August 2023	Improvement Works Applications (if applicable) due
25 August 2023	Council feedback closes**
31 August 2023	Applications close
December 2023	Successful applications announced
December 2024	Projects / acquittals completed

* Preference will be given to clubs who contact Club Development Officer to discuss project. This is an informal process and can be done via email or phone call.

** Council will provide feedback to ensure all sections of the application have been completed. Please note, feedback on answers to criteria will not be provided.



WHAT IS THE SELECTION CRITERIA?

- Complete the application form placing emphasis on the assessment questions:
 - How does your project align with the objectives (60%) (refer to slide 5)
 - Detail the broad community benefit of the project (20%)
 - Detail how your project is a priority for your organisation (10%)
 - Detail how your organisation will manage the project (10%)
- Focus more on solutions than problems when writing your grant application. A real person is going to read your proposal, so you want to instil positive emotions.
- In order to build stronger, sustainable and long-term relationships between Council and community groups, Council will favour applicants that financially contribute to the project.



HOW DO I APPLY?

- Complete the application form placing emphasis on the assessment questions.
- Attach supporting docs including:
 - Quotes
 - Less than \$5,000 = 1 quote
 - \$5,000 \$14,999 = 2 quotes
 - \$15,000 and above = 3 quotes
 - Financial statements for applications over \$5k previous 2 years financial statements or latest treasurers report covering 24 months + current bank statement.
 - Site Plan / aerial image
 - Proof of not-for-profit status (Certificate of Incorporation)
 - Public Liability Insurance (up to \$20 million with CRC noted as an interested party)
 - Current AGM minutes
 - Letter of written consent from the Landowner (if CRC 'in principle support letter)
 - Letters of support from the community (optional but encouraged)



PROCESS

- Grant application period closes (31 August 2023)
- Council Officers undertake an assessment of all eligible applications (September 2023)
- Council Officers prepare report for the Councillors and executive recommending successful applicants (October / November 2023)
- Council finalises the assessment/reporting phase and advises all applicants on the decisions (December 2023)
- Successful applicants enter into Funding agreement with Council and receive funding (December 2023)
- Successful applicants undertake the project and acquit the grant (as per the funding agreement) (2023/24 financial year)



TOP TIPS

To maximise your chances of success, ensure:

- Your club & project are eligible.
- You have Council approval.
- Engage with Club Development Officer.
- Address the selection criteria focus on criteria #1
- Focus on solutions not problems.
- Triple check all supporting documents.
- Submit application early.
