- New playground installed at Allen-Phillips Park, Edmonton (right)
- Improvement works for Greenpatch recreational area underway
- Commenced subsoil drainage works along southern side of Cairns Rd, along the front of the Pyramid Estate Residential Care Centre, Gordonvale
- Design and construction of water main from Dickson Rd to Jackson St, Bruce Highway, underway
- Gordonvale Wastewater Treatment Plant control system upgrade commenced
- Redbank Rd boat ramp carpark upgrade (right)
- Behana Creek remediation works underway
- Commenced installation of new primary sedimentation and associated works at Babinda Wastewater Treatment Plant



- Replacement of inlet screens at Gordonvale Wastewater Treatment Plant underway
- New footpath constructed alongside highway from Post Office to Hotel, Mirriwinni (pictured below)



- Commenced renewal of sewage pump station B1, Howard Kennedy Drive, Babinda
- Bellenden Ker Intake replacement bridge crossing underway
- Commenced water quality monitoring program at Bramston Beach

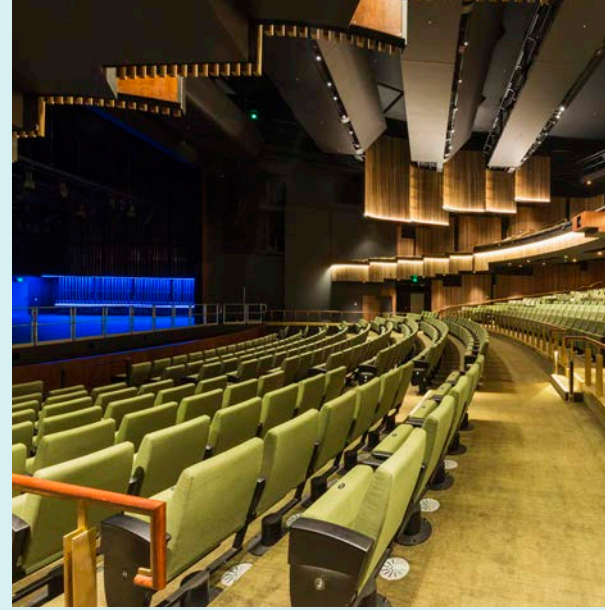
