General Information

- (a) This Council program allows registered charities to use the Lorikeet Barbeque facilities without charge once per financial year for the purpose of fundraising.
- (b) You must use the existing BBQ facilities, no gas flame permitted on the Esplanade.
- (c) The Lorikeet BBQ will be cleaned and reserved for your use. Please ensure you have a copy of your Event Permit with you on the day.
- (d) The BBQ needs to be between the hours of 9.00am and 2.00pm in conjunction with the Saturday Esplanade Markets which run from 8.00am to 5.00pm each Saturday.
- (e) This facility is being made available for “sausage sizzle” type functions selling BBQ food and soft drinks only.
- (f) Nothing is to be pegged into the ground, any signage must be self-standing.
- (g) You are not permitted to ‘spruik’ your BBQ or wander through the facility seeking fundraising donations.
- (h) No vehicles are to be brought on to the parklands for any reason.
- (i) The facility is available on a ‘first come, first served’ basis and while every attempt will be made to ensure the facility is available on your chosen date, there is no guarantee of booking.
- (j) The only infrastructure permissible is a single marquee which you can supply yourself, or request from Leisure Venues prior to the event.
- (k) Anyone selling food to the public should contact the Environmental Health Unit of Cairns Regional Council on (07) 4044 3044 to obtain any necessary permits.

If the use / activity is being conducted on trust land, it may be necessary for the use / activity to be approved under the *Land Act 1994*.

If a trustee lease is required under the *Land Act 1994* for the proposed use / activity, a licence is not required.
