In compliance with Cairns Regional Council's Community Grants Policy 2020, Council is obliged to publish details of all Councillor discretionary funding allocations. These details must be published on Council's website within seven (7) days of the allocations approval. Information to be documented in this publication includes the following:

- a. The Councillor allocating the funds
- b. The purpose of the allocation
- c. The amount allocated
- d. The name of the community organisation receiving the allocation (where applicable)
- e. The date allocated
- f. The way in which the funds were allocated
