



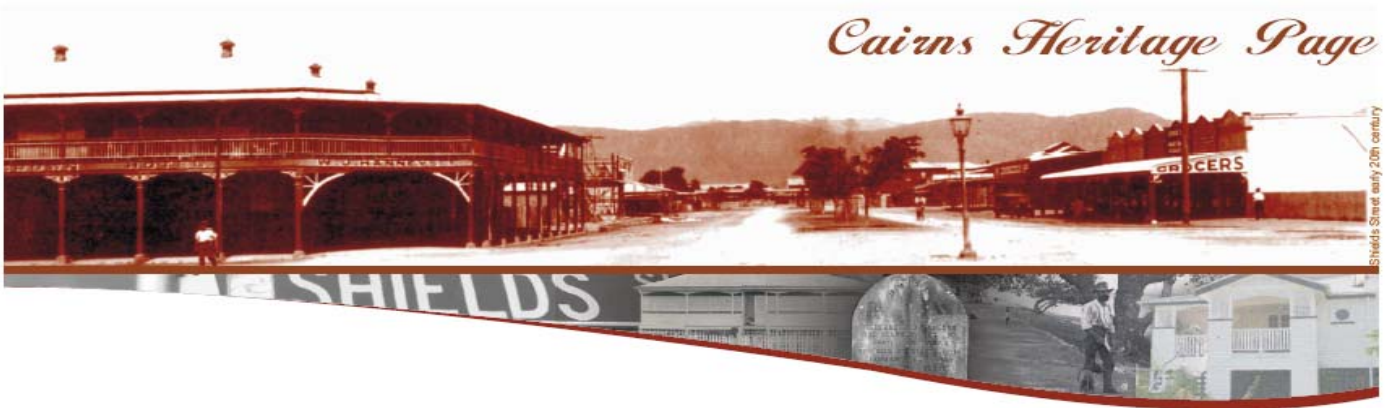

Street Name	Suburb	Street Name Origin
Page Road	Edmonton	Named after Mr J. E. Page, an Alderman of Cairns City Council.
Page Street	Earlville	Named after Mr J. E. Page, an Alderman of Cairns City Council.
Palamino Court	Little Mulgrave	Named for a horse theme.
Palm Avenue	Parramatta Park	Named "Palm Avenue" because it was previously an avenue of palms.
Palm Cove Boulevard	Palm Cove	No information found.
Palm Street	Holloways Beach	Many street names in this suburb were named for a floral theme at the suggestion of resident Ann Edwards. Palm trees grow in places that are warm and have a lot of sunshine, and there are around 2600 species in this family. Common products and food are derived from palms and they are widely used in landscaping because of their exotic appearance.
Palmer Close	Gordonvale	No information found.
Palmer Street	Portsmith	Named after Sir Arthur Palmer (1819–1888) the Premier of Queensland from 1870–1874. The Palmer River and Palmer River Goldfield were also named after him.
Palmerston Street	Aeroglen	Named after Christie Palmerston (1850–1893), an early explorer and pioneer who blazed a track from Geraldton (Innisfail) to Herberton in 1882.
Palmetto Street	Palm Cove	This street was named after a palm theme.
Paluma Street	Mount Sheridan	Named after a ship theme, the HMS Paluma is a survey ship which conducted a marine survey of the Great Barrier Reef circa 1890–93.
Pambula Close	Kewarra Beach	Named after an Australian beaches theme, Pambula is on the

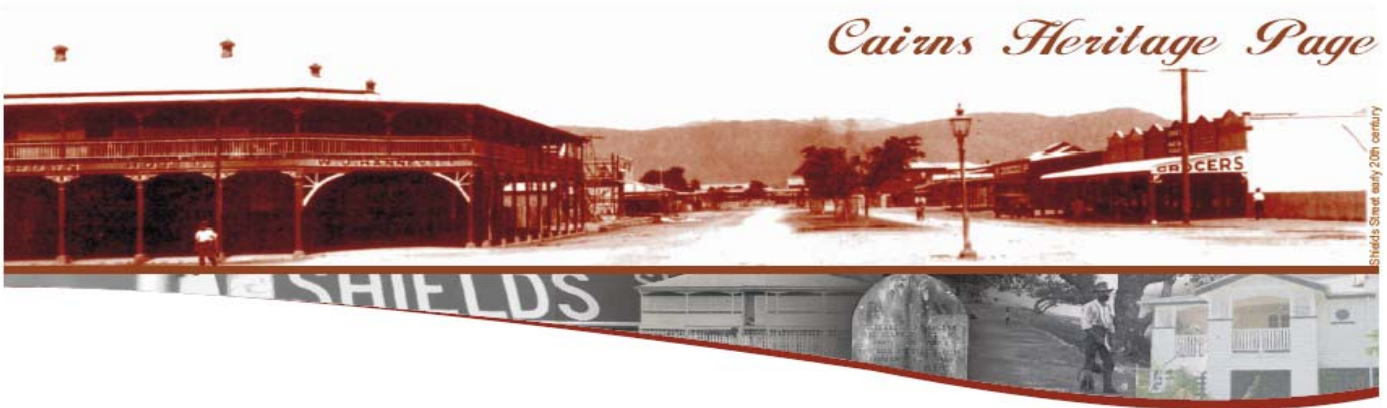


Southern Coast of New South Wales.

Pandanus Street	Holloways Beach	Many street names in this suburb were named for a floral theme at the suggestion of resident Ann Edwards. The <i>Pandanus tectorius</i> , also known as the screw pine, is native to all the archipelagos of Micronesia. It is a large and complex genus found commonly on frontal beach ridges in tropical and subtropical coastal areas.
Pandora Close	Bentley Park	HMS Pandora was sent by the British Admiralty in pursuit of the HMS Bounty mutineers. On returning to England via the Torres Strait with 14 mutineers on board, the Pandora struck the Great Barrier Reef off Cape York and sank on the 29 th August 1791.
Panguna Street	Trinity Beach	Named after a Papua New Guinea theme as suggested by a resident who had served as a coast watcher there in World War II.
Panebianco Access	Babinda	No information found.
Pannikin Street	Goldsborough	Named after a mining theme for the gold mining previously done here.
Panorama Street	Bayview Heights	This street was named for its scenic values.
Panoramic Place	Whitfield	Named for the panoramic views from the street.
Panther Street	Woolanmaroo	No information found.
Papacek Access	Little Mulgrave	No information found.
Papaya Close	Manoora	Many street names in this area are named after tropical fruits.
Paperbark Street	Bramston Beach	No information found.
Par Street	Yorkeys Knob	Named due to its position near the Half Moon Golf Course.

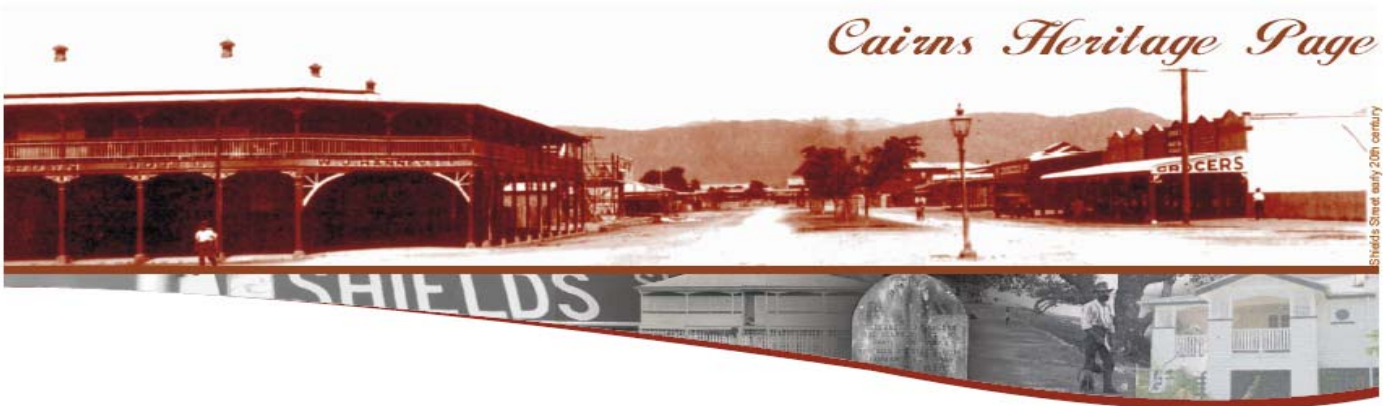

Paramount Close	White Rock	Named for a motion picture theme, Paramount company is a leading movie making company in Hollywood.
Paringa Street	Caravonica	No information found.

Park Street	Whitfield	No information found.
Parkinson Avenue	Clifton Beach	Named after artist Sydney Parkinson who was a member of Captain James Cook's crew in their voyage to Australia above the Endeavour in 1770.
Parkridge Drive	Kanimbla	Named for an environmental theme.
Parkway Street	Trinity Park	No information found.
Parramatta Street	Parramatta Park	Named after the Sydney suburb of Parramatta, and the Parramatta Hotel was on the five ways.
Parry Road	Gordonvale	Named after John Jasper Parry, son of Thomas Henry Parry who was a large cane grower in the Gordonvale area. John purchased a large area of land at Babinda on the western side of the railway line. The Mulgrave Shire Council resumed a portion of this early holding for town and residential use.
Parry Street	Babinda	Named after John Jasper Parry, son of Thomas Henry Parry who was a large cane grower in the Gordonvale area. John purchased a large area of land at Babinda on the western side of the railway line. The Mulgrave Shire Council resumed a portion of this early holding for town and residential use.
Parton Close	White Rock	Named for motion picture theme after much loved American Country



Singer, Songwriter and Actress Dolly Parton. The Mulgrave Shire approved the subdivision. The survey plan was registered with the Register of Titles on 12th April 1985.

Patience Street	Manoora, Manunda	Mr Dan Patience an early manager of Burns Philp and Co and Mayor of Cairns in 1894.
Patrick Close	Gordonvale	No information found.
Patula Close	Manoora	Named after a ship.
Paul Close	Yorkeys Knob	No information found.
Pavetta Close	Bentley Park	This close was named after <i>Pavetta australiensis</i> , which is a perfumed flower that butterflies are attracted to.
Peacock Street	Trinity Beach	Named for a bird theme.
Peakviews Close	Redlynch	For views across the ranges.
Pearce Close	Gordonvale	Named after local family of the area. Mr Pearce senior was the first Timber Mill owner in Gordonvale.
Pearl Close	Bayview Heights	This close was named for a female Christian name theme.
Pease Street	Edge Hill, Manoora	Named after the Honourable Percy Pease (1876–1940), Member of Parliament for the district and Minister of Lands for some of that time. He was born in Westmorland England arriving in Cairns in 1900 and established a merchant and timber firm. He was an Alderman on the Cairns City Council in 1916 and a member of the Cairns Harbour Board 1915–1920. He was on the committee of the Cairns Ambulance Centre from 1908–1916. He won the by-election for the seat of Herbert on 10 April 1920 that he held until his death. In 1929 he was elected Deputy Leader of the Queensland Labor Party in



opposition until 1932. He then took the portfolio of Public Lands and the Deputy Premiership on 17 June 1932.

Peate Close	Edmonton	Named after a former Mount Peter miner, and the streets survey plan was registered on 25/6/1998.
Pecten Close	Trinity Beach	This close was named after the seashell theme of the area. A pecten is the shell of a scallop, <i>Pecten fumatus</i> , and is also well known as being the symbol of the Shell fuel company.
Peever Road	Babinda	Named after the Peever brothers Edward, Vere and Vernon who were involved in sugar cane farming and cutting. Vernon's wife Gladys May resided in Church Street Babinda.
Pelican Street	Deeral	No information found.
Pelizzari Close	Redlynch	This close was named after an early family in the area. A member of the Pelizzari family married into the Chirio family who owned the land this street is located on.
Pelling Close	Kanimbla	Mr J. Pelling was a blacksmith for the Cairns City Council for over 40 years.
Pellowe Street	Clifton Beach	The street is named after Pellowe reef, which is a small isolated reef located east of Green Island close to the edge of the continental shelf in the Great Barrier reef. It is a very exciting diving site where many large fish, sea cucumbers and nudibranchs are often seen.
Pembroke Street	Parramatta Park	Named after the Earl of Pembroke.
Penda Close	Manoora	All streets in this area are based on a tree species theme.
Pennine Close	Smithfield	Named after a mountain theme, the Pennine Mountains are in England.
Penny Close	Whitfield	Named after Mr Richard Gerard Penny, (10/8/1919 – 28/06/1985) who was the secretary/manager of the Cairns RSL from 1960–1980. He also took the role of president/secretary of the Cairns Sub-Branch



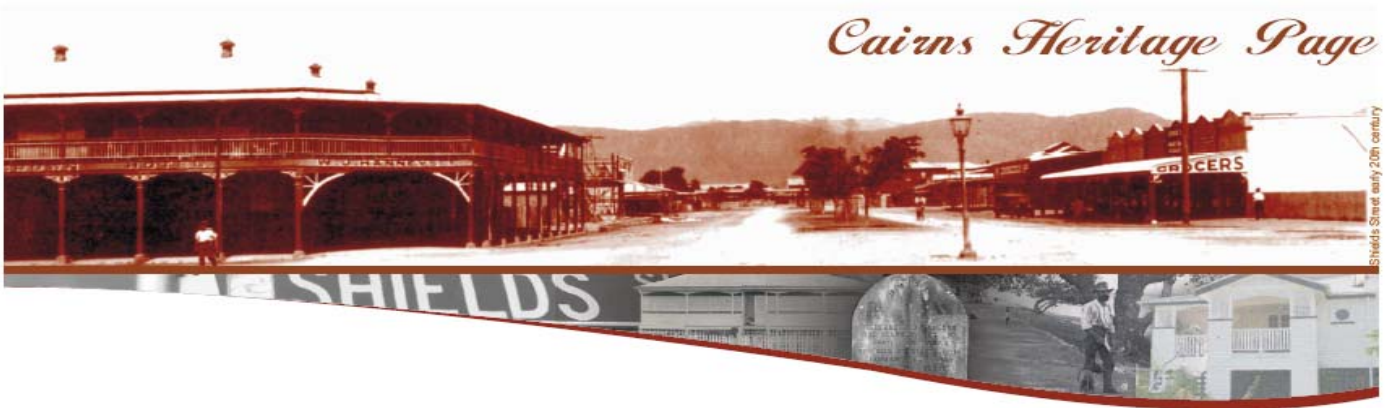

Pepperwood Street	Redlynch	No information found.
Pera Close	Bentley Park	Named after a Dutch ship which was involved in exploration of Northern Australia at the Gulf of Carpentaria in 1606 and was captained by V. Colster.
Perch Street	Kanimbla	No information found.
Percy Street	Mount Sheridan	Named after a ship theme
Peridot Street	Bayview Heights	The streets of this subdivision are named after minerals and gemstone. Peridot is the Jewellers name for olivine and peridoties are minerals consisting of olivine and various other minerals.
Periwinkle Avenue	Trinity Beach	No information found.
Perkins Street	Manoora	Named after Mr Perkins, one time manager of the Cairns Branch of the Bank of New South Wales.
Petersen Close	Manunda	Named by Mr Polentz, who owned land before it was sub-divided after Alderman George Petersen at the turn of the century.
Petersen Road	Edmonton	Named after Peter Petersen who was born in Denmark and travelled to Australia in the ship the Humbolt. He arrived in Cairns in 1897 and was a cane farmer and prospector. In May 1920 his son Henry discovered gold on the family property at Mount Peter. He worked the field with two of his sons and developed the Mount Peter Mines.
Petersen Street	Aloomba	Named after Peter Petersen who was born in Denmark and travelled to Australia in the ship the Humbolt. He arrived in Cairns in 1897 and was a cane farmer and prospector. Phoenix Street	White Rock	Named after a United States of America theme, Phoenix is a city in the state of Arizona.
Piccone Drive	Edmonton	Named after Lou and Luigi Piccone who in 1920 established a shop in the Hambledon area, a long-term resident and is recognised for philanthropic acts.
Picnic Street	White Rock	Named with the movie theme, this name comes from the 1975 movie Picnic at Hanging Rock.
Pier Point Road	Cairns City	After the adjacent pier.
Pilosa Street	Redlynch	Named for a rainforest and water theme after a plant species.
Pinda Close	Edmonton	This close is named after a specific species of sugar cane, and the street was surveyed on 6/9/1973.

Pine Creek-Yarrabah Road	Gordonvale to East Trinity	One of the earliest roads in the district.
Pine Tree Close	Bayview Heights	Named after a tropical tree theme.
Pioneer Street	Manoora	In honour of the Pioneers of the region.
Piper Close	Mount Sheridan	Named after islands off the North Old coast.
Pisa Street	Woree	Named after an Italian theme, Pisa is a town in Italy famous for its leaning tower.
Pitt Court	Earlville	Named for Douglas Pitt the Younger, born 1880 on Murray Island and died in 1925. He was famous for swimming to safety in the 1899, 1918 and 1920 cyclones as well as becoming the first person to swim from Magnetic Island to Townsville.
Pittsburg Street	White Rock	Named after United States of America theme, Pittsburg is the northern most towns in New Hampshire and shares an International border with Canada.
Pixar Street	White Rock	No information found.
Pixie Street	Clifton Beach	Named after the reefs off the Queensland coast.
Plaintain Street	Kewarra Beach	Native bush food theme.
Planchonella Close	Edge Hill	No information found.
Plantation Road	Edmonton	The view from Hambledon House of sugar plantation.
Plath Close	Portsmith	Member of the subdivider's family.
Platypus Close	Mount Sheridan	Named after a ship theme.
Playford Close	Brinsmead	No information found.



Poinciana Street	Holloways Beach	Many street names in this suburb were named for a floral theme at the suggestion of resident Ann Edwards. Poinciana is native to Madagascar and is an introduced weed. It is widely planted as a shade tree in parks, streets and home gardens.
Poinsettia Street	Holloways Beach	Many street names in this suburb were named for a floral theme at the suggestion of resident Ann Edwards. Native to Mexico, the poinsettia is also known as the Mexican flame tree, the Christmas star and the Noche Buena. Its scientific name is <i>Euphorbia pulcherrima</i> , and it is known for its striking red display at Christmas time.
Polentz Circus	Whitfield	Named after Mr Roland (Roly) Polentz who owned a sugar cane farm in Edge Hill. He subdivided the area near the Edge Hill Bowls Club in the late 1950s. Mr Polentz later owned and drove a taxi in Cairns. <small>(Supplied by Mrs Anne Mills nee Woodward, edited by Cairns Regional Council).</small>
Polentz Street	Edge Hill	Named after Mr Roland (Roly) Polentz who owned a sugar cane farm in Edge Hill. He subdivided the area near the Edge Hill Bowls Club in the late 1950s. Pollard Road	Babinda	Named after James Pollard who settled in the area in the late 18 th century. After marriage he adopted Carl Gambassi in order to keep the Pollard name in existence.
Pollock Close	Bentley Park	Named after an Australian river and streams theme. The street survey plan was registered on 4/11/2004.
Pomona Avenue	Mooroobool	Streets in this subdivision are named after a Roman theme. Pomona was the Roman goddess of the fruit tree.
Ponticello Street	Whitfield	Named after the subdivider Mr Ponticello in 1975.
Ponzo Street	Woree	After Domenico Ponzo who purchased in the area (from Mr S. Spoto) in 1988 Mr Ponzo eventually sold the land to the Curcuruto Family. Ponzos originally farmed in Saw-Mill Pocket, Edmonton in the 1930s. <small>(Supplied by Cr. Jeff Pezzutti, compiled by Cairns Regional Council).</small>
Pool Close	Woree	The Woree swimming pool is located in this close. The Cairns City Council approved this name in April 1998.

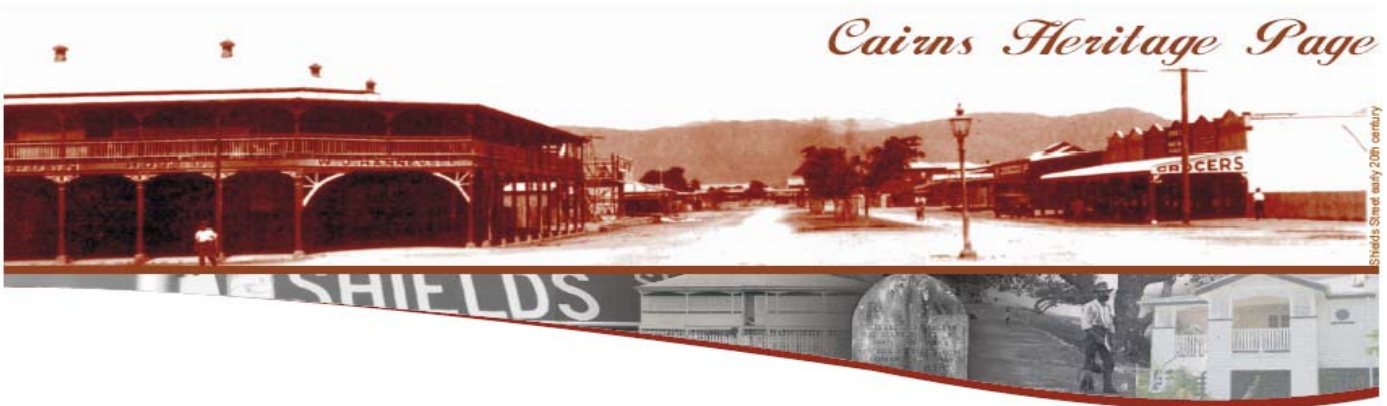

Potts Close	Edmonton	Named after Mr Potts, who was a storekeeper inn the Hambledon district area around 1900.

Prescott Street	Whitfield	Named after Mr Bob Prescott, a friend of the subdivider. Also well know Cairns businessman and owner of Prescott Real Estate - 1890's.

Price Road	Bartle Frere	No information found.
Primo Street	Freshwater	Named after Primo Savina who was heavily involved in community activities in the 1930-40s.
Primrose Street	Mooroolool	The street names in this estate are based on a floral theme.



Prior Street	Edmonton	Named after an early pioneering family. The streets survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire on 15/8/1984.
Prior Street	Machans Beach	Named after Walter Prior who retired to Machans Beach in the 1930s.
Pritchard Close	Gordonvale	No information found.
Progress Road	White Rock	Constructed between 1945 and 1947 as far as Coombs Street. Bitumen surfaced in 1955 and extended to Sheehy road in 1960 and surfaced in 1961.
Propeller Court	Trinity Beach	No information found.
Prospect Close	Edmonton	Named after the Mount Peter Goldfield Prospectors, and the survey plan was registered on 23/8/1995.
Prospector Close	Goldsborough	Named after the Mining theme with the historic gold mining of the district.
Providence Close	Bentley Park	This close was named after HMS Providence, a British naval vessel commanded by Captain William Bligh from 1791-93 to collect botanical specimens from the Pacific.
Pumila Close	Mount Sheridan	No information found.
Purbeck Place	Edge Hill	No information found.
Pyne Street	Edge Hill	Named for the Pyne Family, James Pyne was an early pioneer in the district and was one of the first trustees of the Cairns Cemetery being appointed on 23 December 1877. He was nominated for the Cairns Divisional Board as a member along with Louis Severin in January 1880 and was on the first committee of the Cairns State School, being elected on 7 April 1879. He was the agent for Wilson & Hart's timber merchants of Maryborough, and lived in a cottage on the beach. This land was then acquired by the Department of Education for the Cairns State School.
Pyne Street	Edmonton	Named for the Pyne Family, James Pyne was an early pioneer in the district and was one of the first trustees of the Cairns Cemetery
