Street Name	Suburb	Street Name Origin
Quadrio Crescent	Brinsmead	This crescent was named after an early settling family in the district.
Quail Close	Woree	This close was named for a bird theme after the quail which is a name used for many genera of mid sized birds that are mainly ground dwellers. Some quails however are migratory and fly for long distances. Quails are a popular hunting bird.
Quamby Close	White Rock	No information found.
Quarry Street	Aeroglen	This street was named because it gave access to the Council's quarry.
Queen Street	Edmonton	This street was probably named after Queen Victoria.
Queen Street	Parramatta Park	This street was probably named after Queen Victoria.
Queenley Close	Edge Hill	No information found.
Queensborough Close	Trinity Park	No information found.
Queenscliff Close	Kewarra Beach	Named after an Australian beaches theme, Queenscliff Beach is located on the Peninsula outside Geelong.
Quest Court	Trinity Park	Named after an ocean going yacht.
Quetta Close	Manoora	Named after a ship that sank on the 28 th February in 1890 after striking a rock in the Adolphus Channel with the loss of 133 lives.
Quigley Street	Parramatta Park, Bungalow	This street is in the area of Dan Quigley's paddock, where Moody and Quigley used to paddock and pasture their horses around 1905.
Quinlan Street	Babinda	Named after pioneering family the Quinlans who once lived at the



junction of Quinlan and Munro Streets.

Quinn Drive	Edmonton	No information found.
Quoll Close	Redlynch	This close was named for a rainforest and water theme after the quoll which is a small native marsupial.
Quondong Close	Manoora	All street names in this area are based on a tree species theme. There are different types of Quandong found throughout Australia. The Blue Quandong, <i>Elaeocarpus angustifolius</i> , is found in Far North Queensland and has bright blue fruits and cream flowers.
