


'A' Street Names

Street Name	Suburb	Street Name Origin
Abbott Street	Cairns	This street was named in October 1876 after Henry Palmer Abbott the General Manager for Queensland of the Australian Joint Stock Bank. Abbott came to Cairns immediately after it was established to open a branch of his bank.
Abel Street	Manunda	This street was named after Mr Alf Abel who was a local businessman. The street was surveyed in July 1954.
Abington Close	Redlynch	This close was surveyed on the 11 th August 2004 and was registered with Cairns City Council on the 31 st August 2004.
Acacia Street	Holloways Beach	Many street names in this suburb were named after a floral theme at the suggestion of resident Anne Edwards. Acacia is a genus of tree with approximately 1,300 species worldwide, including many species of Wattle. There are about 950 species that are native to Australia. Most Acacia species are valued for their timber.
Academy Close	White Rock	This close is named after the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences, the masters in film production since 1927. The Academy is most well known for holding the Academy Awards Ceremony. The Mulgrave Shire approved the subdivision. The survey plan was registered with the Register of Titles on the 21 st of July 1983.
Accatino Close	Edmonton	Named after a Hambleton Mill Employee that served for 10 years or more. The close was surveyed on 16/6/1995.
Accatino Street	Edmonton	Named after a Hambleton Mill Employee that served for 10 years or more. The street was surveyed on 16/6/1995.
Acmena Close	Redlynch	The street names for this sub-division were based on a rainforest & water theme. <i>Acmena smithii</i> is the scientific name for a species of Lilly-Pilly, which has small pink & white berries. They are native to Queensland and are usually found in subtropical rainforest areas or in dry rainforest areas near streams.
Adair Street	Yorkeys Knob	Named in honour of Herbert (Bunny) Adair (1905-1994) who served




the State Parliament from 7/3/1953 until 17/5/1969.

Adam Drive	Brinsmead	The first reach of this drive was surveyed on the 11 th May 1984 and was registered with the Mulgrave Shire Council on the 17 th May 1984. The second portion of the road towards the Hobson Drive end was surveyed on the 15 th May 1984 and was registered on the 17 th May 1985.
Adelaide Street	Manunda	HMAS Adelaide was a light cruiser, which was commissioned at Sydney on the 5 th August 1922 under the command of Captain J. B. Stevenson RAN.
Adonis Street	Mount Sheridan	The Adonis was a paddle steamer built in 1883, which was part of a fleet of several vessels that serviced the Tewantin area from Brisbane to Maryborough during the 1870s and 1880s. It was owned by Dath, Henderson and Bartholomew, a milling company, and was able to carry loads of up to 50 logs per trip from the Tewantin sawmills.
Adventure Close	Bentley Park	The HMS Adventure and the HMS Resolution, commanded by Captain Cook, left Britain in July 1772 to circumvent the globe via Cape Horn in South America arriving back in July 1775.
Aeroglen Drive	Aeroglen	This road traverses the suburb of Aeroglen. It was surveyed throughout the 1940-50s and was initially registered with Cairns City Council on the 20 th June 1940.
Agate Street	Bayview Heights	Streets in this subdivision are named after minerals and gemstones. Agate is a common semi-precious silica mineral and is composed of silicon dioxide. Most agates occur in cavities of eruptive rocks or ancient lavas. Banding in the rocks is due to the successive layers being approximately parallel to the sides of the cavity. The varieties of agate are: eye, moss, onyx, riband, ring and white. This subdivision was developed by three Irishmen (Peter Murphy, Richard Moffatt, George Mitchell) trading as M. Industries P/L. The survey plan was registered in May 1973.
Agincourt Close	Clifton Beach	Named after Agincourt reef, which is an outer shelf ribbon reef with an area of 5.1 km ² and is situated 65 km from Port Douglas. It is a series of smaller reefs with at least 16 dive sites including interesting swim throughs and caves. The reef has coral gardens with an abundance of exceptionally coloured reef fish and a spectacular pinnacle where pelagic fish gather to feed.




Ah Ching Close	Brinsmead	Named after Jimmy Ah Ching, an early Chinese settler who did a great deal for local development. He arrived in Cairns in 1876 and owned 100 acres on the north side of Chinaman's Creek. He grew rice from 1885 at the Fairview Estate. The hill at this estate was known as Ah Ching's hill.
Ainscow Drive	Bentley Park	No information found.
Ainslie Place	Smithfield	No information found.
Airlie Close	Mount Sheridan	This close was named after a ship theme. The Airlie was built in 1884 and was sold in 1904 to Burns Philip and Co.
Airport Avenue	Cairns North	This is the road leading to the Cairns Domestic and International Airports.
Ajax Close	Edmonton	Named after a Greek theme, Ajax was a Greek hero and legendary King. The close was surveyed on 23/10/1974.
Akbar Close	Edmonton	Named after a Greek theme, Akbar was said to be a benevolent and wise ruler, a man of new ideas and of sound judgement. Streets in this subdivision are also named after early varieties of sugarcane, some of which were bred by CSR. The close was surveyed on 3/9/1977.
Alabama Street	White Rock	Named after a United States of America theme, Alabama is the 30 th largest State in the USA.
Alamanda Street	Holloways Beach	Many streets in this suburb were named for a floral theme at the suggestion of resident Anne Edwards. Alamanda is an introduced species.
Alamein Street	Stratford	Named after the Battle of El Alamein fought in the deserts of North Africa. The Battle is seen as one of the decisive victories of World War II ending German hopes of controlling Egypt, the Suez Canal and the Middle East oil fields.
Albatross Street	Kewarra Beach	Named after a bird species theme, the term albatross is derived from Arabic and translates to 'the diver'. They were once commonly known as gooney birds and have been described as 'the most




legendary of all birds'.


Alberta Drive	Woree	Streets in this subdivision are named after female Christian names.
Albion Street	Yorkeys Knob	This street was surveyed on the 13 th of August 1973 and the survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire Council on 15/10/1973.
Albizia Close	Redlynch	Streets in this suburb are named for rainforest or water themes. <i>Albizia Julibrissin</i> , <i>Albizia Lebbeck</i> & <i>Albizia Odoratissima</i> are all rainforest tree species.
Alderman Street	Mount Sheridan	This street was surveyed for Daikyo, and the survey plan was registered with the Cairns City Council on the 22 nd July 2005.
Aldinga Close	Whitfield	This close was possibly named after a vessel of the Adelaide Steamship Company.
Alexandra Street	Clifton Beach	Named after Alexandra Reefs off the coast of Queensland.
Alfina Street	Mount Sheridan	No information found.
Alfio Street	Woree	Named after an Italian male Christian name, the street was surveyed on the 28/2/1974 and the survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire on the 27/9/1974.
Alfred Street	Manunda	This street is named after Alfred Street, one of the first arrivals to Cairns. He was a carpenter who opened one of the first stores in Cairns, and invested heavily in Smithfield. He later grew coffee at his Fernhill Plantation in the Kuranda district. He contributed greatly to the community, being elected as an Alderman in 1885, a trustee of the Cairns Cemetery, a member of the Cairns Harbour Board, and a member of the Health Board of Cairns.
Alice Close	Woree	Streets in this subdivision are named after a female Christian name theme.
Alison Close	Edge Hill	Named after the President of the Chamber of Commerce in 1909, Mr Alison.



Alkoo Close	Bayview Heights	This close was surveyed on the 16 th October 1972 and the survey plan was registered with the Cairns City Council on the 16/03/1972.
Allan Street	Bungalow	Named after Mr P. Allan who at one time was a maintenance inspector for Railways in Cairns. He was also a leading Freemason of early Cairns in 1901.
Alley Street	Gordonvale	Named after the pioneering family of Riverstone. The head of the family was William Saunders Alley who arrived in the Gordonvale area from Brisbane and was a timber feller. His son was Graham Gordon Alley born in 1862. He built the Riverstone Hotel in 1880 following the opening of the Mulgrave goldfields.
Allinga Close	Bentley Park	This close was named for a ship theme after the Allinga which was an Adelaide Steamer ship that visited Cairns.
Allyson Street	Smithfield	Streets in this subdivision are named after a female Christian name theme.
Alma Street	Woree	Streets in this subdivision are named after a female Christian name theme.
Almond Street	Holloways Beach	Many streets in this suburb were named after a floral or tree theme at the suggestion of resident Anne Edwards. The almond (<i>Prunus dulcis</i>) is a native of southwest Asia. It is related to the plum, peach, apricot and cherry trees, but lacks the sweet fleshy out covering of the hull.
Alpha Close	Bayview Heights	This close was surveyed on the 14 th October 1976 and the survey plan was registered with the Cairns City Council on the 17/11/1976.
Alphen Street	Gordonvale	This street was surveyed on the 4 th November 1999 and the survey plan was registered with the Cairns City Council on 24/11/1999.
Alpine Close	Edmonton	Named after a mine of the same name that operated between 1917 and 1920, most likely in the Edmonton area.
Alpinia Terrace	Mount Sheridan	This street is named after a genus of ginger that contains 230 species.




Alstonia Close	Redlynch	This close was named after a rainforest or water theme. There are 40-50 species of Alstonia, including <i>Alstonia actinophylla</i> , the Northern Milkwood rainforest tree.
Altona Street	Bentley Park	No information found.
Alva Close	Kewarra Beach	Named after an Australian beaches theme, Alva beach is located near Ayr in North Queensland.
Amadio Close	Gordonvale	No information found.
Amarina Close	Caravonica	This close was surveyed on the 24 th October 1985 and the survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire on 16/12/1985.
Amaroo Close	Smithfield	Amaroo is an aboriginal word meaning 'lovely place'. This close was surveyed on the 4 th October 1982 and the survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire on 23/11/1982.
Amazon Close	Mount Sheridan	Named after a tree theme, the Amazon is a tropical rainforest found near the Suriname/Brazil border in South America.
Amethyst Street	Bayview Heights	Streets in this subdivision are named after minerals and gemstones. An amethyst is a purple gem. The amethyst is a purple variety of quartz and the name is taken from the Greek word meaning 'not drunk' – perhaps in reference to its wine-like colour. Developed by three Irishmen (Peter Murphy, Richard Moffatt, George Mitchell) trading as M. Industries P/L. The survey plan was registered in May 1973.
Amos Close	Redlynch	This close was surveyed on the 15 th February 2001 and the survey plan was registered on 15/2/2001.
Amphora Street	Palm Cove	This street was named after a seashells theme. The species <i>Melo amphora</i> is commonly known as a Baler Shell and can be found on the Great Barrier Reef.
Anderson Road	Aloomba	Named after Mr James Anderson who was one of the first white settlers in Cairns. He operated a shop, and later became an Alderman. The survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire



Council on 31/1/1917.

Anderson Road	Bayview Heights, Woree, White Rock.	Named after Mr James Anderson who was one of the first white settlers in Cairns. He operated a shop and later became an Alderman. The survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire Council on 31/1/1917.
Anderson Road	Gordonvale	Named after Mr James Anderson who was one of the first white settlers in Cairns. He operated a shop and later became an Alderman. The survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire Council on 31/1/1917.
Anderson Street	Manoora, Manunda	Named after Mr James Anderson who was one of the first white settlers in Cairns. He operated a shop and later became an Alderman. The survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire Council on 31/1/1917.
Anderson Street	Trinity Beach	Named after Mr James Anderson who was one of the first white settlers in Cairns. He operated a shop and later became an Alderman. The survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire Council on 31/1/1917.
Andrea Close	Mooroobool	Named after a member of the Koppen family who were the original landowners and developers.
Andrew Street	Stratford	This street was originally surveyed on the 22 nd November 1939 and the survey plan was registered with the Cairns City Council on 4/12/1939.
Andrews Street	Aloomba	This street was originally surveyed on the 29 th November 1954 and the survey plan was registered in the Mulgrave Shire Council on 12/9/1956.
Angel Close	Kanimbla	No information found.
Angela Street	Woree	Streets in this subdivision are named after female Christian names.
Angor Road	Trinity Park	No information found.
Angus Street	Babinda	Named after James Angus who was an early owner of the land on the



western side of the street. The land was later divided into building allotments.


Aniston Street	White Rock	No information found.
Anivas Close	Freshwater	This close is named after the pioneering Freshwater family the Savina's who owned the land before it was subdivided. Anivas is Savina spelt backwards.
Anne Street	Smithfield	Streets in this subdivision are named after female Christian names.
Anniebuka Close	Bentley Park	No information found.
Anson Street	Bentley Park	No information found.
Antonetta Close	Yorkeys Knob	Streets in this subdivision are named after female Christian names.
Aplin Street	Cairns	Named after W. C. Aplin of Clifton Aplin & Co (later Aplin, Brown & Co.), storekeepers of Smithfield in 1876 and later merchants in Cairns. They had a warehouse on the Barron River beside mango trees on the high bank nearly opposite 'Lilybank' at Stratford. This was known as Half-way house.
Apollo Quay	Trinity Park	Named after the ocean going Maxi yacht Apollo, which was a contestant in many yacht races around Australia and overseas. The Apollo also won many races including the Sydney Gold Coast and Sydney Hobart Yacht Races.
Appaloosa Street	Little Mulgrave	Streets in this subdivision are named after a horse theme. The Appaloosa is a breed of horse.
Araminta Street	Bentley Park	Named after a ship that carried immigrants to Australia from 1844–59. The Araminta arrived in Botany Bay in 1854.
Arawa Street	Trinity Beach	This street was originally surveyed on the 29 th May 1974 and the survey plan was registered with the Cairns City Council on the 24/10/1974.



Arbouin Close	Kanimbla	The Arbouin family was an early family in the Cairns area. This street was originally surveyed on the 5 th April 2004 and the survey plan was registered with the Cairns City Council on the 7/5/2004.
Archer Close	Mount Sheridan	This close was originally surveyed on the 5 th October 2000 for Daikyo and the survey plan was registered on the 13/10/2000.
Archibald Street	Edmonton	No information found.
Archie Street	Parramatta Park	The origin of this street name is unknown, but the street was approved at a Cairns Municipal Council Meeting on 11 th December 1922.
Arden Close	Edmonton	This close was originally surveyed on the 18 th June 1976 and the survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire on 22/12/1976.
Ardisia Street	Smithfield	This street was named after <i>Ardisia brevipedata</i> , a Queensland rainforest tree.
Arena Close	Bayview Heights	This close was originally surveyed on the 8 th August 1972 and the survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire on 9/11/1972.
Argentea Boulevard	Palm Cove	No information found.
Argyle Close	Edge Hill	Named after Australia's largest diamond producing mine in the Kimberleys, Western Australia.
Ariel Court	Kanimbla	Named after the early explorer ship Ariel that carried immigrants to Australia in the 1860s. It was this ship that picked up Jacky Jacky of the Kennedy Expedition in 1848.
Arizona Crescent	White Rock	This street was named after a United States of America theme. Arizona was the 48th State to be admitted to the USA in 1912.
Arkendeith Drive	Edmonton	Arkendeith is the name of a fort near Inverness, Scotland and the birthplace of early settler Mr Mann.




Arlington Esplanade	Clifton Beach	Named after Arlington Reef off the coast of Qld, which is a middle shelf crescent reef with an area of 99.5 km ² . The reef is located north of Green Island and east of Buchan's Point.
Armanasco Road	Bramston Beach	Named after M. R. Armanasco who was a Councillor of Cairns Shire Council in 1924–38, 1943–45 & 1947–51.
Armbrust Street	Manoora	This street was named after Nicolas Armbrust the founder of a large pioneering family in Cape York Peninsula. He settled in North Queensland in approximately 1880.
Armstrong Street	Edmonton	Named after R. A. Armstrong, Councillor of Mulgrave Shire Council 1956–60.
Arnhem Close	Bentley Park	Named after a Dutch explorer ship that sailed Far Northern waters in 1623.
Arno Terrace	Bentley Park	Named after a Roman theme, the Arno is a 240km long river that begins in the Northern Apennines, Tuscany and flows into the Ligurian Sea in Italy.
Arnold Street	Machans Beach	Named after local resident Mr Gus Arnold and his family.
Arnold Street	Aeroglen	Named after Mr L. Arnold who was the District Forestry Officer in Cairns.
Aroona Street	Caravonica	This street was originally surveyed on the 6 th of July 2000 and the survey plan was registered with the Cairns City Council on 30/6/2000.
Aropa Street	Trinity Beach	Many streets in this area are named after Papua New Guinean localities. Aropa is a town on the coast of Bougainville Island in Papua New Guinea.
Arovo Street	Trinity Beach	This street was named after a theme of localities of Papua New Guinea. Arovo is a Papua New Guinean Island with many of the residents having completed a tour of duty in World War II.
Arran Close	Edge Hill	The close was originally surveyed on the 30 th April 1984 and the survey plan was registered with the Cairns City Council on




18/6/1984.

Arrunga Close	Woree	This close was originally surveyed on the 8 th of April 1974 and the survey plan was registered with the Cairns City Council on 18/8/1979.
Arthur Lyons Drive	Redlynch	This drive was originally surveyed on the 1 st of June 1989 and the survey plan was registered with the Cairns City Council on 4/1/1990.
Arthur Street	Manunda	No information found.
Aruma Close	White Rock	This close was originally surveyed on the 30 th of April 1974 and the survey plan was registered with Mulgrave Shire Council on 30/9/1974.
Arunta Street	Trinity Park	Streets in this subdivision were named after ships. The HMAS Arunta was an Australian Navy Destroyer.
Ascendant Close	Bentley Park	This close was named after a ship that carried immigrants to Australia from Europe between 1844 and 1859.
Ascot Avenue	Westcourt	This avenue was originally surveyed on the 23 rd of July 1935, and the survey plan was registered with the Cairns City Council on 13/2/1936.
Ash Street	Holloways Beach	Streets in this area were named after a floral and tree theme at the suggestion of resident Anne Edwards. The ash tree has four different tree genera. The wood is hard, tough and very strong but also elastic and used where high strength and resilience is need.
Ashwood Circuit	Smithfield	No information found.
Aspen Close	Mount Sheridan	Streets in this subdivision were named after trees. The Aspen (<i>Populus tremula</i>) is characterised by its shimmering foliage in summer.
Assman Road	Aloomba	This road was named after an early farming family in the district. The survey plan was registered in the Mulgrave Shire on 31/1/1969.



Atherton Street	Whitfield	Named after Alderman E. Atherton, Alderman of Council from 1927–1929. He was also the local member of Parliament and the Minister of Mines. He was the son of pioneer John Atherton who discovered tin in the Tablelands.
Atherton Street	Yorkeys Knob	Named after Alderman E. Atherton, Alderman of Council from 1927–1929. He was also the local member of Parliament and the Minister of Mines. He was the son of pioneer John Atherton.
Atkinson Street	Manunda	Named after photographer Alfred Atkinson (1867-1950) who set up a studio in partnership with James Handley. From 1915 to 1918 he was elected an Alderman and for a short time was acting Mayor of Cairns.
Atkinson Street	Machans Beach	This street was named after Keith Atkinson who is a life member of the Machans Beach Progress Association.
Atkinson Street	Manunda	Named after photographer Alfred Atkinson (1867-1950) who set up a studio in partnership with James Handley. In 1915 to 1918 he was elected an Alderman and for a short time was acting Mayor of Cairns.
Atlantic Street	White Rock	This street was named after a theme of Cities of the United States of America. Atlantic City is located in the state of New Jersey.
Atlas Close	Smithfield	This close was named after a mountain theme. The Atlas Mountains are located in Morocco and Algeria in Northern Africa.
Atticus Street	Woree	This street was named after a Roman theme. Titus Pomponius Atticus was an ancient Roman litterateur.
Augustus Street	Mooroobool	All street names in Forum Estate are predominantly based on a Roman Theme. This street was named after Augustus Caesar who was the first Roman Emperor and grandnephew of Julius Caesar.
Auld Close	Gordonvale	This close was named after an early farming family in Gordonvale. The survey plan was registered on 5/5/2005.
Aumuller Street	Bungalow, Westcourt	This street was named after Mr Karl Aumuller who arrived in Cairns in 1885, and was elected to Mayor of Cairns in 1898. He was a



saddler and hardware merchant as well as a Justice of the Peace.

Aurelia Road	Palm Cove	No information found.
Australis Close	Edmonton	The <i>Phaius australis</i> orchid is commonly known as the tall swamp orchid and is the largest of the ground orchids. It is on the endangered species listing.
Avery Street	Edmonton	Named after a Hambleton Mill Employee that served for 10 years or more.
Avoca Close	Kewarra Beach	Named after an Australian beaches theme, Avoca Beach is located on the Central Coast of New South Wales.
Avocado Close	Manoora	The Queensland Housing Commission requested that all street names in Brookside Estate be related to tropical fruits.
Avoch Close	Edmonton	Named after its proximity to the Scottish fort of Arkendeith. This close is located in Arkendeith Estate.
Avon Street	Stratford	Named after word association Stratford upon Avon, the Avon River is a major river in England.
Avondale Street	Mount Sheridan	Named after an early ship of the Cairns area.
Azalea Court	Mooroobool	Azaleas are colourful flowering shrubs of the genus <i>Rhododendron</i> . This street was surveyed on the 27 th of September 1983 and was registered on the 14 th of December 1983.
