Information for Tours

Thank you for your interest in touring Cairns Regional Council's water facilities. Please ensure that all members of your group have read, understand and agree with the information below.

COST: Free

WHEN: Tours are available Monday to Friday, excluding Public Holidays.

TIME: Tours run between 10am and 1pm for up to 2 hours.

TOUR NUMBERS: To ensure maximum benefit, tours are limited to a total of 20 participants. If you have a larger group please contact Council to discuss so your needs can be accommodated.

CHILDREN: Tours are recommended for children aged 13 or above.

TRANSPORT: All groups are required to organise their own transport needs. Please note there is a vehicle limit on the Lake Morris Road, with any vehicles over a 12 seater bus prohibited.

ACCESS and FACILITIES: All sites have different levels of accessibility, with some having multiple stairs. Please refer to table above which indicates what is available in terms of access and facilities at each of the sites. If you have any special requirements please specify on this form and we will endeavour to accommodate your needs.

WHAT TO WEAR: For safety reasons, enclosed footwear is essential and no one will be allowed to participate in a tour without the required footwear.

WHAT TO BRING: As part of the tour, visitors will be spending time outdoors and should bring their own sunhat, insect repellent, water bottle and wet weather attire if needed. The Cairns Regional Council is not liable for the loss or damage of any personal belongings.

EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS: Tours may be re-scheduled in extreme weather events.

SAFETY: It is essential that all visitors follow the directions of their tour guide at all times. A list of all visitors must be available in case of emergency evacuation. For safety reasons, a ratio of 1 adult for every 8 school students is required.
