

## Application to Locate a Temporary Structure Within a Drainage Easement

This application has been introduced to allow people to apply for certain low impact, temporary structures to be placed within a drainage easement. Consideration will only be given to this if sufficient information is supplied to demonstrate that the structure will have no or negligible impact on the operation of the easement and that access for any maintenance of the easement will be possible for Council crews. Please ensure that the latest version of the form is used to submit an application. (See our website: <http://www.cairns.qld.gov.au> then click on 'forms and permits', 'roads and easements'). If the easement also contains sewerage infrastructure, an additional application is required: follow the 'Plumbing Services' link to the application form.

If the proposal involves a permanent structure such as a garage or extension to a dwelling, this application form should not be used. In such situations the matter must be addressed to the Department Environment Resources, Mines & Energy (DNRME) ☎ 1300 255 750, to apply to surrender an easement or part thereof. DERM will then liaise with Council regarding the need for the easement and request comment on its surrender if appropriate.

It is important to note that additional approvals may be required if the structure triggers the need to obtain a building approval (e.g. has a roof) or is in close proximity to a boundary such that it may impact on a neighbour's privacy or amenity. In such cases, the applicant must also contact a Private Certifier to obtain approval.

Approval will only be granted for a temporary structure subject to Cairns Regional Council receiving appropriately detailed information, drawings, photographs etc. of the proposal/site. All applications must attach a copy of the Survey Plan and easement document (Usually titled 'Schedule' or 'Memorandum of Grant of Easement') which is associated with the 'Survey Plan'. The application must be signed by the landowner and in doing so, agrees to the conditions identified on the last page of this application form. All approved applications will be noted on the Council's property file.

It should be noted that should an application be approved by Council, it is on the understanding that the structure must not interfere with the intended use of the easement and can be easily removed by the landowner upon request, or by the Council, for which a charge may be made.

Depending on the location and the nature of the proposal, Council may require a meeting with the applicant on site in order to gain easy access to the easement to better appreciate the proposal and consider any feature which may hinder approval.

**It should be noted that no construction works can commence within an easement without first obtaining written approval from Cairns Regional Council.**
