





### 'C' Street Names


Street Name	Suburb	Street Name Origin
Cabarita Street	Kewarra Beach	Many streets in this subdivision are named after Australian beaches. Cabarita beach is a beach in northern New South Wales situated close to the Gold Coast, which offers great surfing opportunities.
Cable Close	Kewarra Beach	Named after an Australian beaches theme, Cable beach is located in Broome, Western Australia.
Cadaga Close	Manoora	Street names within Soderberg sub-division are based on a tree species theme. The <i>Eucalyptus torelliana</i> is commonly known as Cadaga, which is a fast growing tree reaching heights between 13.5 and 18m and has a bloom of white flowers.
Caddy Street	Yorkeys Knob	Named after a golfing theme, as the streets here are near the Half Moon Bay Golf Club.
Cadell Street	Bentley Park	This street was named after an Australian rivers and streams theme. The Cadell River is located in central Arnhem Land in the Northern Territory.
Cadzow Court	Edmonton	This street was named after an early Edmonton settler who was part owner of the "Specimen Hill" mine.
Caesar Close	Mooroobool	All street names in Forum Estate are predominantly based on Roman theme. Gaius Julius Caesar was a Roman military and political leader. He was considered to be one of the foremost military geniuses of his time, a brilliant politician and one of the world's strongest leaders.
Caesar Street	Bentley Park	Named after a ship that carried immigrants to Australia between 1844 and 1859.
Cairnorm Close	Smithfield	Named after mountain theme, the Cairnorm Mountains are in Scotland.
Cairns Road	Gordonvale	Named after J. Cairns, Councillor of Cairns Divisional Board 1898–1901.



Cairns Street	Cairns North	Named after John Cairns who was first associated with the mining fields and came to Cairns around the turn of the 19th century to open an auctioneering business and act as a land and general agent.
Cairns Western Arterial Road	Caravonica	No information found.
Cairnwell Street	Smithfield	Named after mountain theme, the Cairnwell Mountains are in Scotland.
Calamus Court	Palm Cove	This street was named after a palm theme. The Calamus belongs to several genera known as rattan palms. The <i>Calamus australis</i> is known as the hairy mary, wait-a-while or lawyer cane.
Calder Street	Edge Hill	Named after Mr William James Calder, a prominent real estate businessman. Originally Cairns manager of the Commercial Bank of Australia, Mr Calder joined Mr Charles Woodward Snr as partner of Woodward and Calder Real Estate in 1919. The business expanded into retail furniture.  Both partners retired in 1945.

Caleb Court	Kanimbla	Named after a distinguished soldier from World War 1.
Callaghan Street	Mooroobool	Named after an early pioneer.
Callitris Street	Redlynch	This street was named for a rainforest and water theme after Callitris, which are Australian cypresses. There are 19 species in the genus which are named after the Greek words 'callos' meaning beautiful and 'treis' meaning three, for the 3-whorled leaves.
Callum Street	Mooroobool	This street was named after a member of the Koppen family who were the original owners of the land.
Calvert Close	Bentley Park	No information found.
Cambanora Place	Kanimbla	Name of old plantation and homestead of 160 acres owned by Archibald Meston.



Cambrian Avenue	Smithfield	Named after a mountain theme, the Cambrian Mountains are in Wales.
Cameron Close	Smithfield	Named after a mountain theme, the Cameron Mountains are in the south-west corner of Fiordland, New Zealand.
Campbell Street	Gordonvale	Named after Charles Campbell, a community minded one-time Councillor of Mulgrave Shire Council and president of the Cairns Chamber of Commerce in 1926.
Cananga Close	Kamerunga	Named after the Ylang Ylang tree ( <i>Cananga odorata</i> ) which originates from Indonesia. Oil made from the flowers of this tree has a calming effect.
Candlenut Close	Mount Sheridan	The candlenut ( <i>Aleurites moluccana</i> ) was burnt in ancient Hawaii to provide light. It has spiritual significance of hope and renewal in Hawaii.
Canecutter Road	Edmonton	Named in recognition of the pivotal role sugar cane played in this district.
Caneland Court	Redlynch	Named after the land's former use as sugar cane farming.
Canna Street	Holloways Beach	Streets of this suburb were named after a floral and tree theme upon the suggestion of resident Ann Edwards.
Cannon Street	Gordonvale	Named after the pioneering brothers William and John who were early dairy farmers and then sugar cane growers in the Highleigh area. Joe Cannon had a livery stables business in Norman Street. (A. J. Hesp, Mulgrave Shire Historical Society Dec. 1977).
Cannon Street	Manunda	Named after Mr John Cannon, a pioneer of the sugar industry.
Canopy Close	Freshwater	No information found.
Canopy's Edge Boulevard	Smithfield	No information found.
Cantal Close	Smithfield	Named after a mountain theme, the Cantal mountains are in




Auvergne, France.

Caper Street	Mount Sheridan	The caper ( <i>Capparis spinosa</i> ) is native to the Greek archipelagos. It is best known for its edible buds and fruit, which are usually consumed, pickled.
Capitano Close	Mooroobool	Named after a deceased Cairns Solicitor, Carlo Capitanio.
Capri Close	Kewarra Beach	This close was named for an Australian beaches theme after the Isle of Capri at the Gold Coast.
Capricorn Street	Bentley Park	This street was named after Capricorn Inlet in Queensland. The street was surveyed on the 1st of November 2005 and was registered with the Cairns City Council on the 22 <sup>nd</sup> of November 2005.
Captain Cook Highway	Aeroglen to Ellis Beach	Originally known as the Cairns Douglas Road until 1932 when named after Captain James Cook.
Carbeen Close	Holloways Beach	Streets of this suburb were named after a floral and tree theme upon the suggestion of resident Ann Edwards. Carbeen, <i>Corymbia tessallaris</i> , is a fast growing evergreen tree, which is found extensively throughout the Queensland coast, Northern Territory and Western Australia. The lower trunk of the tree is dark greyish with rough, cracked bark, whereas the top of the tree is smooth and grey or white in colour.
Carbine Close	Smithfield	Named after a mountain theme, Mount Carbine is a mountain and a town on the Atherton Tablelands.
Card Avenue	Manunda	Named after G. M. Card, a civil engineer who was Manager of the firm T.J. Watkins Ltd at the time of development of the subdivision.
Cardamine Street	Kewarra Beach	This street was named for a native bush food theme. Cardamine, known by the common name of bittercress, is derived from the Greek word 'kardamon' referring to a Persian or Indian herb with pungent leaves.
Cardamon Street	Mount Sheridan	This street was named for a spice theme. Cardamom ( <i>Elettaria cardamomum</i> ) is the common name for certain plant species native




to India and south-east Asia.


Caribbean Street	Holloways Beach	Named after the Caribbean Pine, <i>Pinus caribaea</i> , also known as yellow pine, which is grown in plantations in Queensland and can grow to 30m tall. The street was surveyed on the 16th November 1984 and was registered with the Mulgrave Shire Council on the 15th March 1985.
Carina Close	White Rock	Streets in this area are named after municipalities of Queensland and Carina is a suburb in Brisbane. The street was surveyed on the 30th April 1974 and was registered with the Mulgrave Shire Council on the 30th September 1974.
Carmel Close	Woree	Named after a female Christian name theme.
Carmelo Close	Whitfield	This close was surveyed on the 14th August 2003 and was registered with the Cairns City Council on the 1st September 2003.
Carmen Street	Earlville	This street was named after a well known Butchering Company in Cairns, although the name is misspelt and should be Carman. The firm began in January 1919 when brothers Frank, Bede, Bert and Mark P Carman bought into the butchering firm of the Atherton Brothers which was owned by their brother-in-law, Jack Atherton. The Shop was situated in Spence Street. In the early 1920s, Jack Atherton was bought out, and the shop name was altered to Carman Bros with Frank Carman as the older brother assuming the role of Manager (Jeremy Hodes, FNQ Places and Street Names, Aug1998).
Carnation Drive	Mooroobool	The estate in which this street exists is based on a floral theme. The carnation ( <i>Dianthus caryophyllus</i> ) has three dominant types – annual carnations, border carnations and perpetual flowering carnations. Their origins range from southern Russia to Alpine Greece and the Auvergne mountains of France.
Carne and Richards Access	Edmonton	This road leads to the farm that was owned by Carne and Richards and is now owned by a descendant of Carne.
Carolyn Close	Yorkeys Knob	Named after a female Christian name theme.
Carpenter Close	Edmonton	The close was surveyed on the 15th November 1994 and was registered with the Cairns City Council on the 6th February 1995.




Carramar Crescent	Caravonica	The Carramar tree is more commonly known as the stringy bark tree that is any of several eucalypts having fibrous inner bark.
Carron Close	Bentley Park	Named after an Australian rivers and streams theme, the Carron River located near Koombuloomba Dam approximately 100km south of Cairns.
Carroo Street	Bayview Heights	This is a word which refers to sea bream and carp.
Carrum Close	Kewarra Beach	Named after an Australian beaches theme, Carrum is a beach on the outskirts of Melbourne.
Carruthers Street	Edmonton	Named after a Mount Peter Goldfields miner.
Cartwright Road	Eubenangee	No information found.
Caryota Close	Palm Cove	Named after a palm theme, this palm <i>Caryota zebina</i> is more commonly known as the zebra fishtail palm.
Cascades Drive	Redlynch	Named after the nearby Crystal Cascades popular swimming hole.
Casella Street	Earlville	Named after S. Casella, an early cane farmer in the district.
Cashmere Court	Redlynch	Named after cashmere that is goat hair. It was originally the down undercoat of the Asiatic goat and in the 1880s was known as the Fabric of the Kings. It takes a goat 4 years to grow enough hair for one jumper.
Cassandra Close	Mooroobool	This street was named after a member of the Koppen family who were the original owner of the land.
Cassava Street	Holloways Beach	Streets in this suburb are named after a floral and tree theme suggested by resident Ann Edwards. Cassava or manioc ( <i>Manihot esculenta</i> ) is the tropical starchy staple of Asia, Africa and South America. Nutritionally it is comparable to potatoes but it has twice as much fibre content and a high level of potassium.



Cassia Street	Edge Hill	Cassia ( <i>Cinnamomum aromaticum</i> ) is an evergreen tree native to southern China and the mainland of Southeast Asia. Like its close relative cinnamon, it is used primarily for its aromatic bark that is used as a spice.
Cassia Street	Holloways Beach	Streets in this suburb are named after a floral and tree theme suggested by resident Ann Edwards. Cassia ( <i>Cinnamomum aromaticum</i> ) is an evergreen tree native to southern China and the mainland of Southeast Asia. Like its close relative cinnamon, it is used primarily for its aromatic bark that is used as a spice.
Cassowary Street	Freshwater	This street is located in former cassowary habitat where cassowaries were plentiful when the street was surveyed.
Castaways Close	Kewarra Beach	Named after an Australian beaches theme, Castaways Beach is a beach at Noosa Queensland.
Castlereagh Street	Gordonvale	This street was completed in three stages with surveys done between the 3 <sup>rd</sup> of April and 6 <sup>th</sup> of September 1984. The different sections were registered with the Mulgrave Shire Council between the 24 <sup>th</sup> of May and 8 <sup>th</sup> of October 1984.
Castor Street	Clifton Beach	This street is named after Castor Reef of the Great Barrier Reef off the Queensland Coast.
Casuarina Street	Holloways Beach	Street names in this suburb were named after a flora and tree theme as suggested by resident Ann Edward. The Casuarina genus is commonly called she-oaks or Australian pine. It prefers wind-swept locations, and is often planted as a wind-break.
Catalano Access	Goldsborough	Name after an early farming family in the district.
Catherine Close	Edmonton	Named after early exploratory ship in the Northern waters, first surveyed on 21/12/92.
Cathy Street	Yorkeys Knob	This street was named after Cathy Eddie, a former female staff member of the former Mulgrave Shire Council.
Cattalano Access	Babinda	Named after an early farming family in the district. The survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire on the 20/3/1967.



Cattana Access	Smithfield, Yorkeys Knob	Named after the family who owned and farmed the property here.
Cattana Road	Smithfield	Named after the family who owned and farmed the property here.
Cattle Street	Edmonton	Named after Mr Cattle, early resident and storekeeper. First surveyed in 1935.
Cattleya Close	Edmonton	This is the genus name of an orchid which is known as the 'corsage' orchid, and is well known for its large showy flowers. Street surveyed 4/8/1997.
Cava Close	Bungalow	Cava, also known as Kava or <i>Piper methysticum</i> has traditionally been cultivated by the Pacific Islanders for use as social and ceremonial drink.
Cavalcade Street	White Rock	Named after United States of America theme, presidential cavalcades are a feature of this country.
Cavallaro Avenue	Earlville	Named after a family that lived in this area.
Cavanagh Street	Woree	This street was surveyed in 1938.
Cavendish Street	Earlville	No information found.
Cayley Street	Trinity Beach	This street was surveyed in two sections on the 4th June and 30th October 1975 and both were registered with the Mulgrave Shire Council on the 13 April 1976.
Cecil Street	Aloomba	This is a very short street, at the end of which lived Cecil Street, in the 1940's and early 1950's, thus he gave his whole name to the street. The street was surveyed on the 25th January 1938 and was registered on the 6th October 1938.
Cedar Road	Palm Cove	Named due to the heavy use of the road in transporting cedar timber.
Cedrela Close	Kamerunga	<i>Cedrela odorata</i> is the most common species in the mahogany family




of Meliaceae and is commonly known as West Indian Cedar. It is an important source of timber, producing a lightweight fragrant wood with good resistance to termites, rot and wood-boring insects.

Celebration Close	Clifton Beach	This close was named after Celebration Reef a middle shelf patch reef with an area of 10 square km. This street was surveyed on the 30th January 2002 and was registered with the Cairns City Council on the 13th March 2002.
Celtis Close	Redlynch	This close was named for a rainforest and water theme after a plant species. The <i>Celtis occidentalis</i> is the Greek name for the Hackberry tree, which is a tough, large and fast growing tree. It is native to China, Japan and Korea, and was introduced into Australia as an ornamental and shade tree and has become a major environmental weed.
Centaur Street	Trinity Park	Streets in this subdivision were named after ships. The Centaur was an Australian navy Hospital Ship.
Centenary Close	Manoora	This close was subdivided in the year of Australia's Bicentenary 1976.
Chamberlain Road	Aloomba	No information found.
Chandra Close	Redlynch	No information found.
Chapel Close	Brinsmead	This close was surveyed on the 19th July 2001 and was registered with the Cairns City Council on the 1st August 2001.
Chaplain Avenue	Manunda	Mr A.S. Chaplin owned the land before it was sub-divided.
Charlekata Close	Freshwater	No information found.
Charles Street	Cairns North, Manunda, Parramatta Park	Christian Name Theme.
Charlotte Close	Woree	Named after female Christian names.




Charnley Avenue	Bentley Park	No information found.
Chataway Street	Mooroobool	Named for Alderman D. E. Chataway also Mayor between 1960 and 1967.
Chatham Terrace	Smithfield	No information found.
Chay Road	Edmonton	Early pioneering family of daughter Ann Linneman,
Chelsea Close	Kewarra Beach	Named after an Australian Beaches theme, Chelsea Beach is on the Melbourne outskirts.
Cherry Close	Mount Sheridan	The streets in this subdivision are named after a ship theme. The Cherry Venture was a Singaporean registered 1600 ton cargo ship. On a voyage from Auckland to Brisbane with little ballast and no cargo, the ship was at the mercy of the wind and titled. She was driven hard aground and was carried on to the Maroochydoore coast on 9 July 1973.
Chesney Road	Bartle Frere	No information found.
Chester Court	Manunda	Named for Henry Marjoribanks Chester, Police Magistrate 1885.
Chesterfield Close	Brinsmead	Streets in this area are often named after early district settlers. This street was surveyed on the 12th September 2003 and was registered with the Cairns City Council on the 1st October 2003.
Cheviot Street	Smithfield	Named after a mountain theme, Cheviot Mountain is part of the Tripoli Range in Alberta, Canada.
Cheyne Close	Bentley Park	No information found.
Chirio Drive	Redlynch	The Chirio family owned the land on which this street is located.
Christensen Street	Machans Beach	Named after David Christensen, Mulgrave Shire Councillor 1943 – 1957 and 1961 – 1972. His family were first to cultivate sugar cane at Freshwater. His wife was a schoolteacher and taught at Redlynch




Primary School when it opened in 1932.

Christian Street	Babinda	Named after John Evelyn Christian an early settler who owned a large area of land on the eastern side of the railway line at Babinda. Mr Christian took an active role in the sports of tennis and cricket.
Christie Drive	Brinsmead	Named after early explorer, expert bushman and prospector, Christie Palmer. In the 1870s he marked out several tracks throughout the North, including one to link the coast with the mining regions in the hinterland. He died in Malaya in 1897 aged 46.
Church Street	Babinda	Named after the presence three denominations of Churches. The survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire on 19/3/1941.
Church Street	Gordonvale	Named after the presence of a Church. The survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire on 2/10/1964.
Chystanthus Street	Trinity Park	No information found.
Cicero Close	Mooroobool	All streets that exist in this estate are based on a Roman theme. Marcus Tullius Cicero was born in 106 BC and was murdered in 43 BC. His life coincided with the decline and fall of the Roman republic, and he was an orator, lawyer, politician, and philosopher.
Cilento Close	White Rock	Streets in this subdivision are named for a motion picture theme. Named after Queensland born Actress Diane Cilento who featured in Halfway Across the Galaxy and Turn Left. She was married to Sean Connery from 1962 – 1973, and then married English playwright Anthony Shaffer from 1985 until his death in 2001. The Mulgrave Shire approved the subdivision. The survey plan was registered with the Register of Titles on 20 June 1988.
Cinderella Street	Machans Beach	Machans Beach Progress Association was asked to submit names for this street. Resident Jan Coulter suggested 'Cinderella', poor old Cinderella with no bitumen road, mail deliveries or beach.
Cintra Street	Mount Sheridan	Named after a ship theme, the Cintra was a ship in the service of the Adelaide Steamship company in the late 1890s.
Clacherty Street	Stratford	Named after Bob Clacherty, nicknamed 'Hydro Bob' who was a



member of the Barron Shire Council in the early 19th century.

Claderia Street	Edmonton	Streets in this subdivision are named after a species of Orchid. Claderia is a semi-terrestrial orchid genus with two species, one being found in South East Asia and one in New Guinea.
Claim Close	Goldsborough	Named after the Gold mining that was once done in the district.
Clare Street	Parramatta Park	This street was named for a Christian names theme.
Claridge Close	Mount Sheridan	No information found.
Clarke Street	Gordonvale	Named after Joe Clarke, an early cane farmer in the Highleigh area, which is the region of Highleigh Road.
Clarke Street	Manunda	Mr Arthur. H. Clarke from 1906 - 1949 was auditor for the Cairns Chamber of Commerce and on whom honorary life membership was bestowed.
Clearwater Street	Freshwater	After water theme. John B. Soderberg and William J Wallace developed this subdivision. The Mulgrave Shire approved the subdivision. The survey plan was registered with the Register of Titles on 20 June 1988.
Cleary Close	Gordonvale	Named after pioneering family in the district. The survey plan was registered with the Mulgrave Shire on 11/7/1989.
Cleland Street	Gordonvale	Named after William Cleland, an early pound-keeper. His daughter Mrs Alice Sorensen spent the greater part of her life as a school teacher in Gordonvale.
Clemson Avenue	Edge Hill	Named after Mr Frank Clemson, the owner of the property at the time of sub-division and also a local builder and contractor.
Cliff Close	Mount Sheridan	Named after islands off the North Queensland coast.
Cliffdale Street	Bentley Park	This street was named after the Cliffdale Creek which is located in the Gulf of Carpentaria region of Queensland. The street was



surveyed on the 8th of June 2005 and was registered with the Cairns City Council on the 20th of June 2005.

Clifford Street	Mooroobool	No information found.
Clifton Road	Clifton Beach	Named due to its being Access to Clifton Beach
Clinton Street	Yorkeys Knob	The street was named after John William Clinton who purchased the land in 1960. The street was surveyed on the 14th April 1960 and was registered on the 27th May 1960.
Clohesy Court	Kanimbla	Named after Native Mounted Police Sub-Inspector T Clohesy in the 1870s-80s.
Close Street	Mooroobool	Named for P.G. Close, Mgr Director of Cairns Post Pty Ltd.
Clune Court	Edmonton	An employee of the Hambleton Sugar Mill who served more than a decade, the street was surveyed in 16/6/1995.
Clyde Road	Babinda	Possibly named after the vessel, The Clyde that was employed in the local beche-de-mer industry and was berthed in the Russell and Mulgrave Rivers at times.
Coates Street	Edmonton	This street was named after an early Hambleton cane inspector. The street was surveyed on the 9/3/1989.
Coccoloba Close	Redlynch	This close was named for a rainforest and water theme after the <i>Coccoloba uvifera</i> , which is commonly known as the sea grape because in late summer it bears purplish fruit, with a diameter of 2 centimetres in large grape-like clusters.
Cochrane Street	Manunda, Mooroobool	Named after the Cochrane family. Mr Michael Leiper Cochrane (1864–1934) was the second Town Clerk in Cairns from 1898-1916 and was also the first acting Secretary of the Cairns Harbour Board. Prior to his service to the Council he was with the Queensland National Bank from 1886. He was a breeder and judge of Ayrshire cattle as well as being a member of several Masonic Lodges in the Cairns District.
Cochrane Street	Stratford	Named after Samuel Cochrane who took up property near Stratford




that he called Lilybank on 27 March 1878. He grew maize, English potatoes, sweet potatoes and pumpkins. He also owned the Lilybank Hotel. Around 1889 selling his property to A J Draper he left Cairns.

Coconut Street	Holloways Beach	Streets in this suburb are named after floral and tree theme after a suggestion from resident Ann Edwards. The coconut ( <i>Cocos nucifera</i> ) that is believed to come from Spanish meaning 'monkey-face'. One tree can produce up to 50 nuts, and a tree can live up to a hundred years. All parts of the coconut tree provide a use including shade, food, drink, matting, and shelter.
Cocus Crescent	Palm Cove	Named after a type of palm with wood used in wind instruments.
Cohen Close	Gordonvale	Named after pioneering family.
Colbeck Close	Mount Sheridan	No information found.
Coleus Court	Mooroobool	Named after a plant species. In the genus of Solenostemon has 60 species. It is native to tropical Africa and Asia, and with colourful variegated leaves it is a low maintenance houseplant.
Collett Close	Kewarra Beach	This close was surveyed on the 19th January 1994 and was registered with Cairns City Council on the 10th March 1994.
Collingwood Close	Gordonvale	This close was surveyed on the 5 <sup>th</sup> April 1995 and was registered with the Cairns City Council on the 19 <sup>th</sup> May 1995.
Collins Avenue	Edge Hill	Named after Alderman W.A. Collins who was Mayor of Cairns from 1927-1949, and whose estate was known as Shannon-vale. He had a chemist shop at the corner of Lake and Shield Streets. He passed away in 1959.
Collinson Street	Edmonton	Named after William Hunter Collinson, who was an early selector on Wright Creek. He was also an early butcher, who in partnership with George Mackay had a business in Abbott Street. He was elected to the Cairns Divisional Board 1880–1902.
Collinson Street	Westcourt	Named after William Hunter Collinson, an early butcher, who in partnership with George Mackay had a business in Abbott Street where the Ling and Tovey Chemist shop was later established, and




later relocated to Lake Street near the Central Hotel location.

Colombia Street	White Rock	Named for a motion pictures theme, after the Colombia film studios, being one of the major film studios and producing many films.
Colonel Cummings Drive	Buchans Point	This street is named after Colonel Clement James Cummings who was born in Atherton in 1908 and served the Australian Military from 1929 to 1945. Colonel Cummings served in many places around the world including the United Kingdom, the Middle East and New Guinea where he received a gun shot wound to the chest in
Colonial Close	Redlynch	Historical and sugar cane theme of previous uses of the district.
Comet Street	Bayview Heights	This street was surveyed on the 25th August 1976 and was registered with the Mulgrave Shire Council on the 8th November 1976.
Cominos Place	Manunda	Mr George E. Cominos, a prominent businessman, owned the land before it was sub-divided. He also owned and ran Cominos Cafe.
Commercial Place	Earlville	Named because this street is positioned in a commercial precinct.
Compass Close	Edge Hill	Named because the straight street bears due north (360 degrees).
Comport Street	Portsmith	Named after G.R. Comport, Manager of Cairns Branch of the National Bank about 1880.



Coolamon Terrace	Mount Sheridan	This tree ( <i>Syzygium moorei</i> ) is a very rare tree found in the lowland rainforests in southeast Queensland and north-east New South Wales. It has clusters of watermelon pink gum-like flowers forming masses along leafless branches gives it the common name of Watermelon tree.


Coolum Close	Kewarra Beach	Named after an Australian beaches theme, Coolum is a surf beach on the Queensland Sunshine Coast.

He was also a botanical collector and several plant species are named after him. He died in 1899 at the age of 50 years and is buried in the McLeod Street Cemetery.




