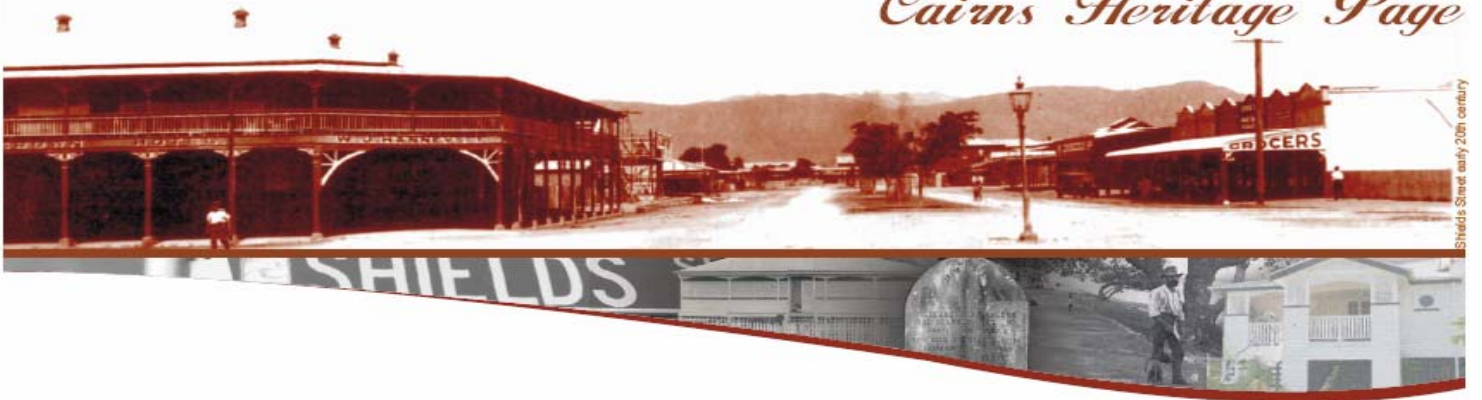




'U' Street Names

Street Name	Suburb	Street Name Origin
Ulambi Close	White Rock	No information found.
Undine Street	Clifton Beach	Named after Undine Reef off the Queensland coast.
Unity Street	Clifton Beach	Named after Unity Reef off the Queensland coast.
Universal Close	White Rock	This close was named for a motion picture theme after the Universal Studios which date back to 1906 when Carl Laemmle opened his first Nickelodeon theatre in Chicago. The Mulgrave Shire approved the subdivision. The survey plan was registered with the Register of Titles on the 6 th August 1982.
Upham Road	Miriwinni	No information found.
Upolu Esplanade	Clifton Beach	Named after Upolu Reef off the Queensland coast. The Upolu Cay was named after the Schooner Upolu owned by William Pitts of Sydney that was wrecked off Cairns on the 25 th April 1886. Situated north of Green Island Upolu Cay has breathtaking coral gardens, exotic marine life and soft white coral sands.
Upper Miles Street	Manoora	The upper reaches of Miles Street, named after W. Miles who was the Queensland Minister of Works when the decision was made to build the Cairns Range railway in 1885.
Upper Perkins Street	Manoora	The upper reaches of Perkins Street, named after Mr Perkins one time manager of the Cairns Branch of the Bank of New South Wales.
Upper Richardson Street	Edge Hill	No information found.
Upward Street	Cairns City, Parramatta Park	Named after George Upward an early shipping agent from late 1876 and a storekeeper. He owned a sawmill in Upward Street for a short time in the late 1870s. He also owned the vessel Fitzroy, which he purchased from W.B. Ingham. When the Cairns economy slumped he left the district.
