Lamb Range

It is believed that the range was discovered and named by the explorer George Elphinstone Dalrymple in 1873. He named it after Edward William Lamb (1828 – 1910). Edward William Lamb was the Member of the Queensland Legislative Assembly for the Electorate of Mitchell from 1868 to 1869, and the Member for the Electorate of Leichhardt from 1870 to 1871. He served as the Secretary for Public Lands from 1867 to 1868. Robson's Track was blazed, somewhere around 1879, by John Robson, along the Mulgrave Valley and up the steep Lamb Range, and was to form part of the Gillies Highway.
