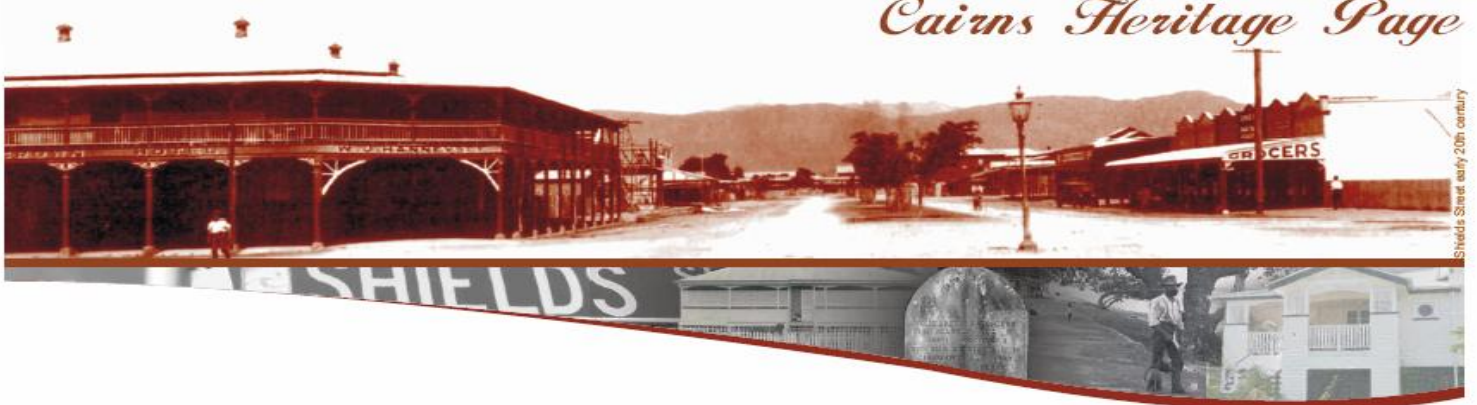




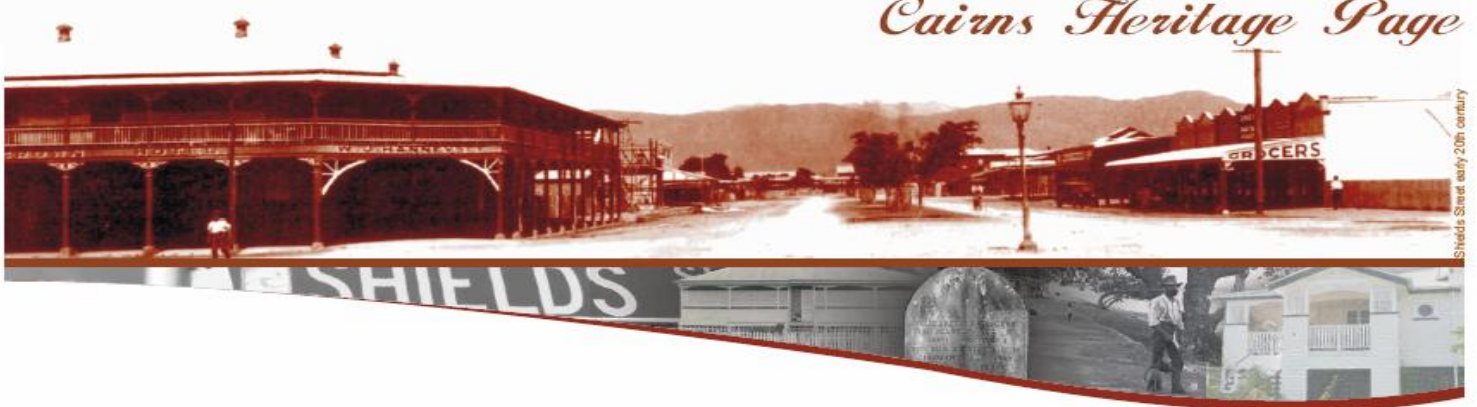
'V' Street Names

| Street Name | Suburb | Street Name Origin |
|--------------------|---------------|--|
| Valda Close | Edmonton | Named after Mrs Valda Ravizza, the first wife of Mr George Ravizza, an Edmonton local who was a well known philanthropist. The survey plan for this Close was registered on 23/4/1992. |
| Valla Close | Kewarra Beach | Named after Valla Beach in northern New South Wales. |
| Vallely Street | Freshwater | Named after a long established local family. |
| Valmadre Street | Caravonica | No information found. |
| Vanda Close | Edmonton | Named after the common name for a species of orchid. The survey plan was registered on 11/12/1995. |
| Vandeleur Street | Earlville | Named after a property owner in the area. |
| Varese Street | Woree | Named after an Italian theme, Varese is a city in Italy. |
| Varley Street | Yorkeys Knob | Named after Lucie Marcella Varley, who owned the land where Yorkeys Knob is situated from around 1920. Matron Varley, as she was known, opened the first hotel in Yorkeys Knob in the 1920s. |
| Vasey Esplanade | Trinity Beach | No information found. |
| Vauclause Close | Kanimbla | No information found. |
| Veivers Close | Westcourt | Named after the Veivers family who owned a cane farm at Palm Cove. Vivian Hector Veivers was the Chief Draftsman of the Cairns City Council from 1940–1975. He was born on the 8 th June 1915 and died on the 13 th June 1980. Walter Hill Veivers moved his family to Freshwater in 1883 and with Toohey operated the first bullock teams in the district pulling timber from the southern side of Trinity Inlet. |
| Veivers Road | Palm Cove | Named after the Veivers family who owned a cane farm on the southern side of the road. Vivian Hector Veivers was the Chief Draftsman of the Cairns City Council from 1940–1975. He was born |

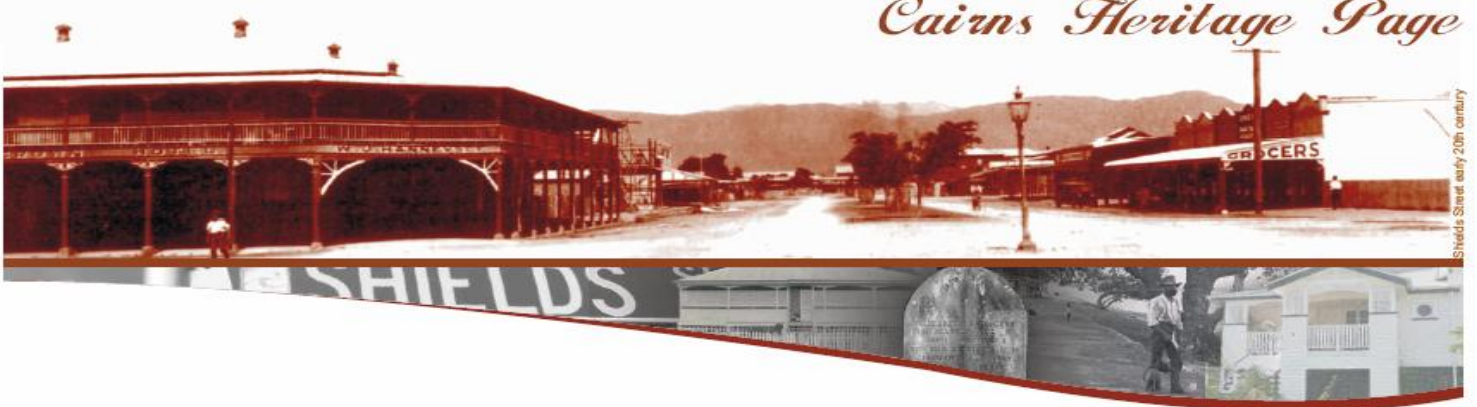


on the 8th June 1915 and died on the 13th June 1980. Walter Hill Veivers moved his family to Freshwater in 1883 and with Toohey operated the first bullock teams in the district pulling timber from the southern side of Trinity Inlet.

| Velma Close | Woree | Named for a female name theme. |
| Venezia Street | Woree | Named after an Italian theme, Venezia is a town in Venice. |
| Venice Close | Kewarra Beach | Named after beaches theme, Venice Beach is a famous beach in California, USA. |
| Venus Battery Close | Edmonton | Named after the Charter's Towers plant that treated the Mount Peter ore. |
| Verbena Drive | Mount Sheridan | This street was surveyed and registered in many different stages between 1994 and 2004. The plans were originally registered with the Mulgrave Shire Council however the later stages were registered with the Cairns City Council. |
| Vernon Street | Mount Sheridan | This street was named after a ship theme. The wooden ship <i>Vernon</i> was a training ship that was used for some time in the late 1800's as a nautical school and reformatory for teenage boys who learned trades under naval discipline |
| Vetiver Street | Trinity Park | No information found. |
| Vianen Close | Bentley Park | Named after an early ship named Vianen. |
| Vickers Street | Edmonton | This street was named after early settlers in the district. |
| Vico Street | Gordonvale | Named after Don Vico, a farmer from Gordonvale who owned the farm that Crystalbrook is built on. The plans for the street were approved by the Mulgrave Shire Council in December 1985. |
| Victoria Street | Parramatta Park | Named after the S.S. "Victoria", the ship on which lunch was held to celebrate the declaration of Cairns as a port of entry on the 1 st November 1876. |

| Victory Close | Edmonton | No information found. |
| View Street | Brinsmead | The street was developed in two stages. The first part was surveyed on the 11 th of October 1972 and was registered with the Mulgrave Shire Council on the 1 st of February 1973. The second stage was surveyed on the 30 th of July 1974 and was registered on the 1 st of October 1975. |
| Vigilant Close | Bentley Park | Named for a ship theme after the HMAS Vigilant which was a survey ship. |
| Villa Street | Bayview Heights | Named after a scenic theme. |
| Village Terrace | Redlynch | Named for a historical and sugar cane theme. |
| Villiers Street | Edge Hill | No information found. |
| Vine Close | Bayview Heights | Named for a tropical plant theme. |
| Viola Close | Bayview Heights | Named for a female Christian name theme. |
| Violet Street | Mooroobool | Many street names in the estate in which this street exists are based on a floral theme. |
| Vista Street | Bayview Heights | Named for its scenic values. |
| Vivian Close | Westcourt | Named after Mr Vivian Hector Veivers the Chief Draftsman of the Council from 1936-1975. |
| Vohland Road | Aloomba | Named after the Vohland family, an old farming family of the area. |
| Volute Close | Trinity Beach | Named after a seashell theme, the volute is a scroll like ornament that forms the basis of the Ionic order found in the capital of the Ionic column. The word is derived from the Latin 'voluta' meaning scroll. |

| Vrackie Street | Smithfield Heights | Named after Ben Vrackie a mountain in Scotland that reaches 841m. |
| Vulcan Street | Aeroglen | Named after the Vulcan Foundry. |
| Vulture Street | Deeral | Many streets in this area are named after species of birds. Vultures are scavenging birds that feed on the carcasses of other animals. They are usually bald headed and are divided into two groups the old world vultures and the new world vultures. |
