

**AMENDMENT TO DECLARATION OF SERVICE AREAS (WATER AND SEWERAGE)**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

That Council:

1. **Adopt the amended water and sewerage service areas as described in Attachment 1 of this report as part of an annual review pursuant to section 161 of the *Water Supply (Safety and Reliability) Act 2008*.**
2. **Make mapping of the updated declared water service area and the declared sewerage service area publicly available by publishing on the Cairns Regional Council website.**

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

It is a requirement for Council to declare amended water and sewerage service areas to meet statutory compliance obligations.

Legislation under the *Water Supply (Safety and Reliability) Act 2008* requires that declared services area mapping be reviewed annually and that Council may amend adding or removing areas by resolution.

The current review has amended mapping primarily to add several development areas within the Cairns Northern beaches and Edmonton/Mount Peter areas. Additional areas specific for Water Service Areas only are included in the Goldsborough Valley.

The additional areas are consistent with development approvals for residential subdivisions and no significant or anomalous results were realised during the review.

No declared service areas were removed from the mapping during the current review.

**BACKGROUND:**

As a registered water and sewage service provider under the *Water Supply (Safety and Reliability) Act 2008* ('the Act'), Cairns Regional Council ensures that connections, disconnections and changes to water supply and sewerage infrastructure are systematically managed to meet customer needs, protect public health and minimise the impact on the environment.

The Act, which is administered by the Department of Local Government, Water and Volunteers (DLGWV), provides the framework for delivering water and sewerage services in Queensland, including the requirement of local governments as entities under the Act to identify and map relevant service areas.

On 24 May 2019, amendments to section 161 of the Act commenced which requires local governments in Queensland that supply a reticulated water service or sewerage service, to 'declare' service areas for those Services.

For local governments that had not declared service areas for the Services under the former 161(1) of the Act, those local governments were required to, by resolution, make a certain declaration in relation to those Services by 24 May 2020. The initial resolution was carried unanimously by Council on 13 May 2020 and has been undertaken annually since this date.

The purpose of the declaration of water and sewerage service areas is to provide clarity about who can and who cannot be connected to Council's water and sewerage infrastructure.

Legislation requires that declared services area mapping be reviewed annually, and that Council may amend adding or removing areas by resolution. This annual review has been undertaken each year since the original adoption, enabling Council to update the Declared Services are to include any new areas of development and to ensure all information is kept current.

In March 2026 Council officers undertook the annual review of the declared water and sewerage service areas, this resulted in some minor amendments. These minor amendments have been mapped and will be made publicly available on the Cairns Regional Council website.

### **COMMENT:**

During the current annual review period there have been minor changes to the Declared Services Area (Water and Sewer) that are consistent with development within the region. No significant changes to Declared Service Areas have been noted.

### **OPTIONS:**

#### **Option 1: (Recommended)**

That Council:

1. Adopt the amended water and sewerage service areas as described in Attachment 1 of this report as part of an annual review pursuant to section 161 of the *Water Supply (Safety and Reliability) Act 2008*.
2. Make mapping of the updated declared water service area and the declared sewerage service area publicly available by publishing on the Cairns Regional Council website.

## Option 2:

That Council does not support the amended water and sewerage service areas and requests additional information from Council officers.

## **CONSIDERATIONS:**

### Risk Management:

#### *Governance, accountability and ethical decision*

It is a legislative requirement that local government must declare their water and/or sewerage service areas and review on an annual basis.

### Council Finance and the Local Economy:

No budget allowance considerations and no costs associated with the declaration request.

### Community and Cultural Heritage:

Improved access for community to view updated water and wastewater service delivery areas through Council website.

### Natural Environment:

No natural environment considerations associated with the declaration request.

### Corporate and Operational Plans:

The services forming the basis of this report relate to the following goals in Council's Corporate Plan 2025 to 2030:

- Robust Economy: "Supporting a diversified and resilient economy"; and
- Design for Liveability: "A place-based approach that celebrates our community".

### Statutory:

It is a statutory requirement pursuant to section 161 of the *Water Supply (Safety and Reliability) Act 2008* that Council amend and make publicly available declared water and sewerage service areas.

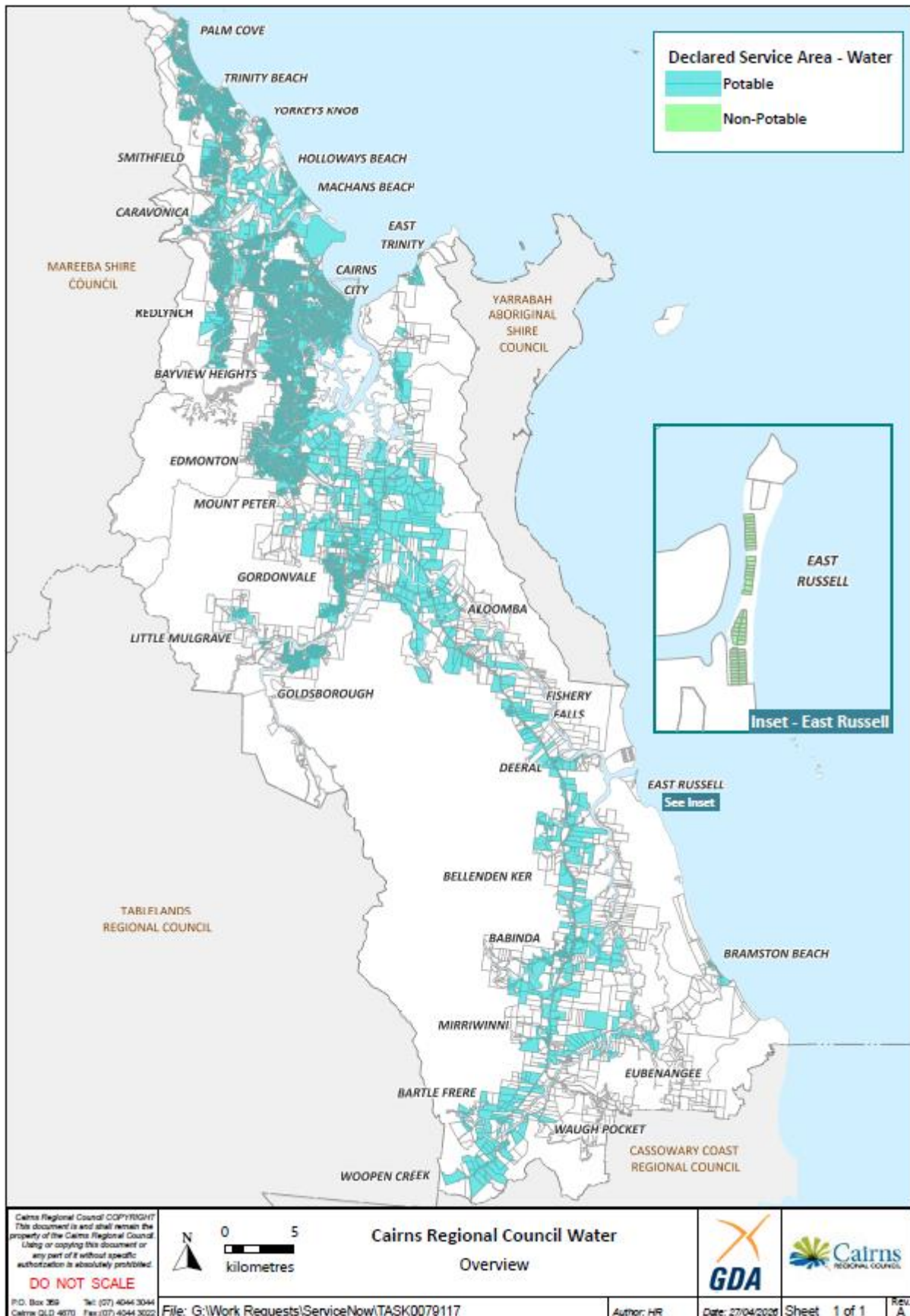

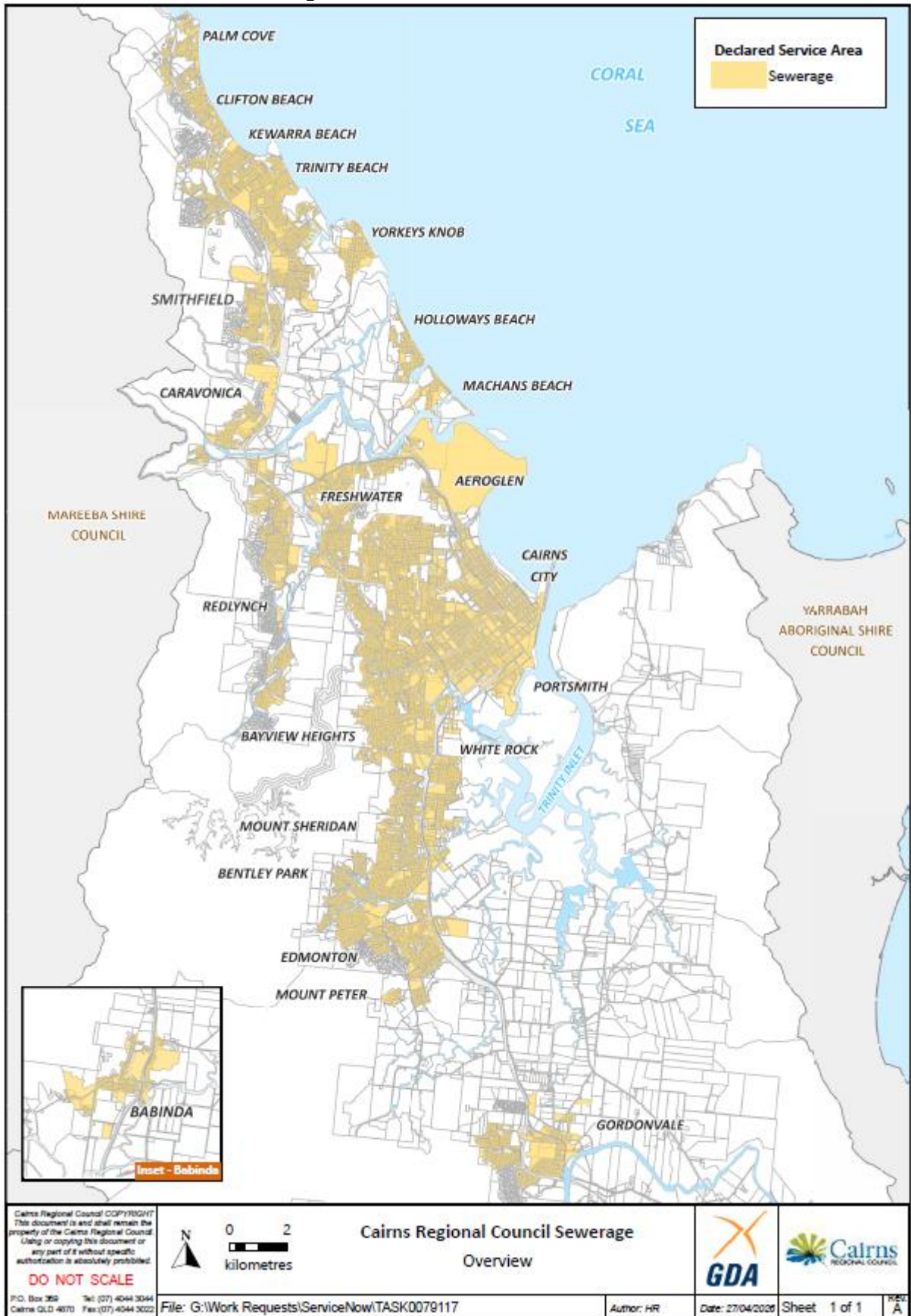
